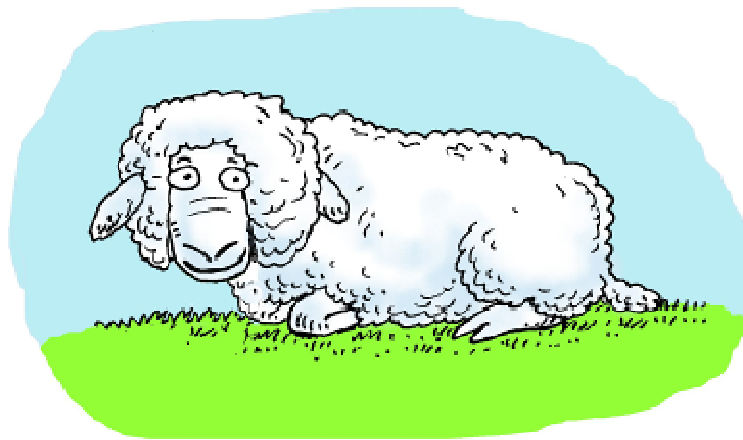


David Looks After The Sheep.

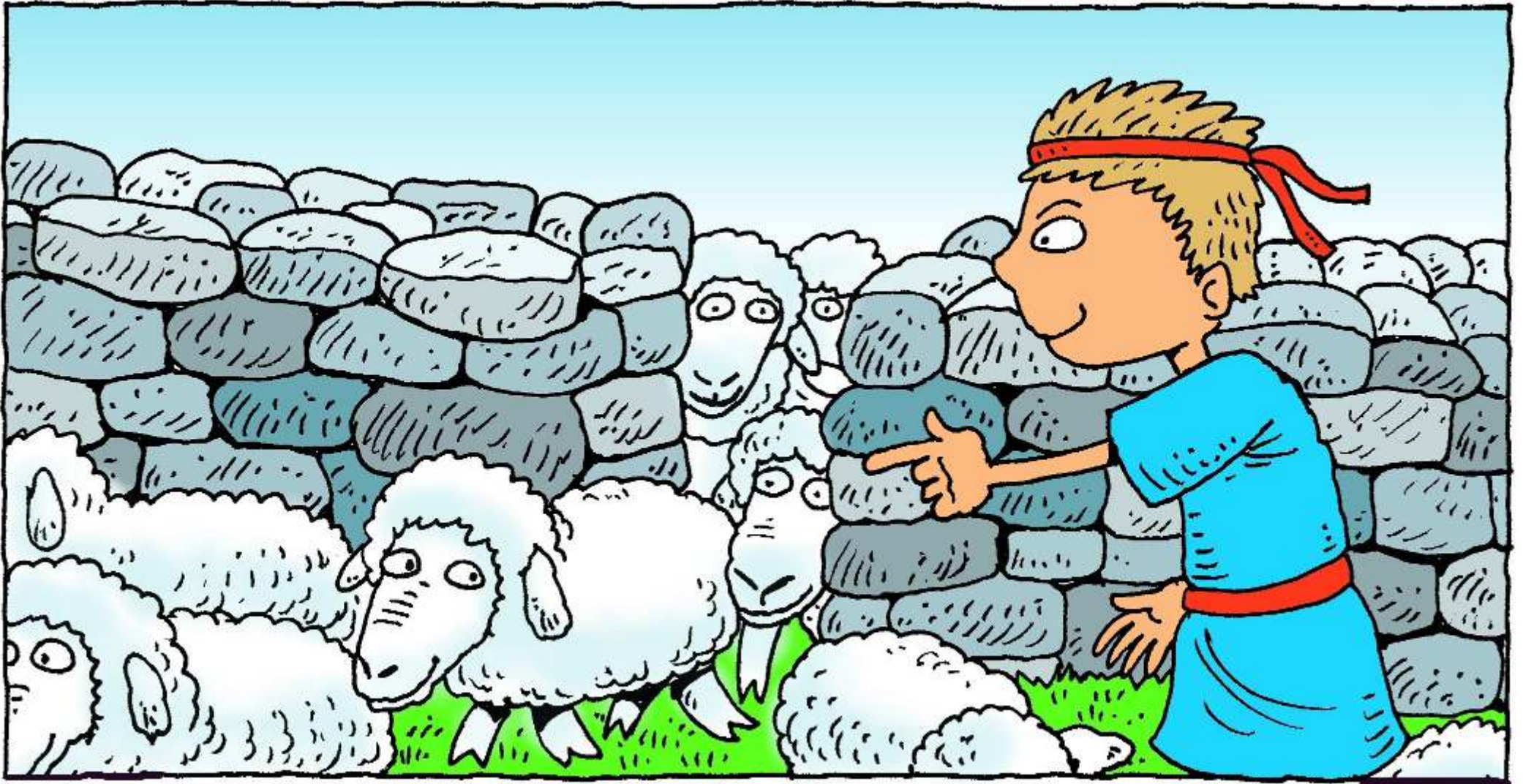




David looked after his Dad's sheep.
