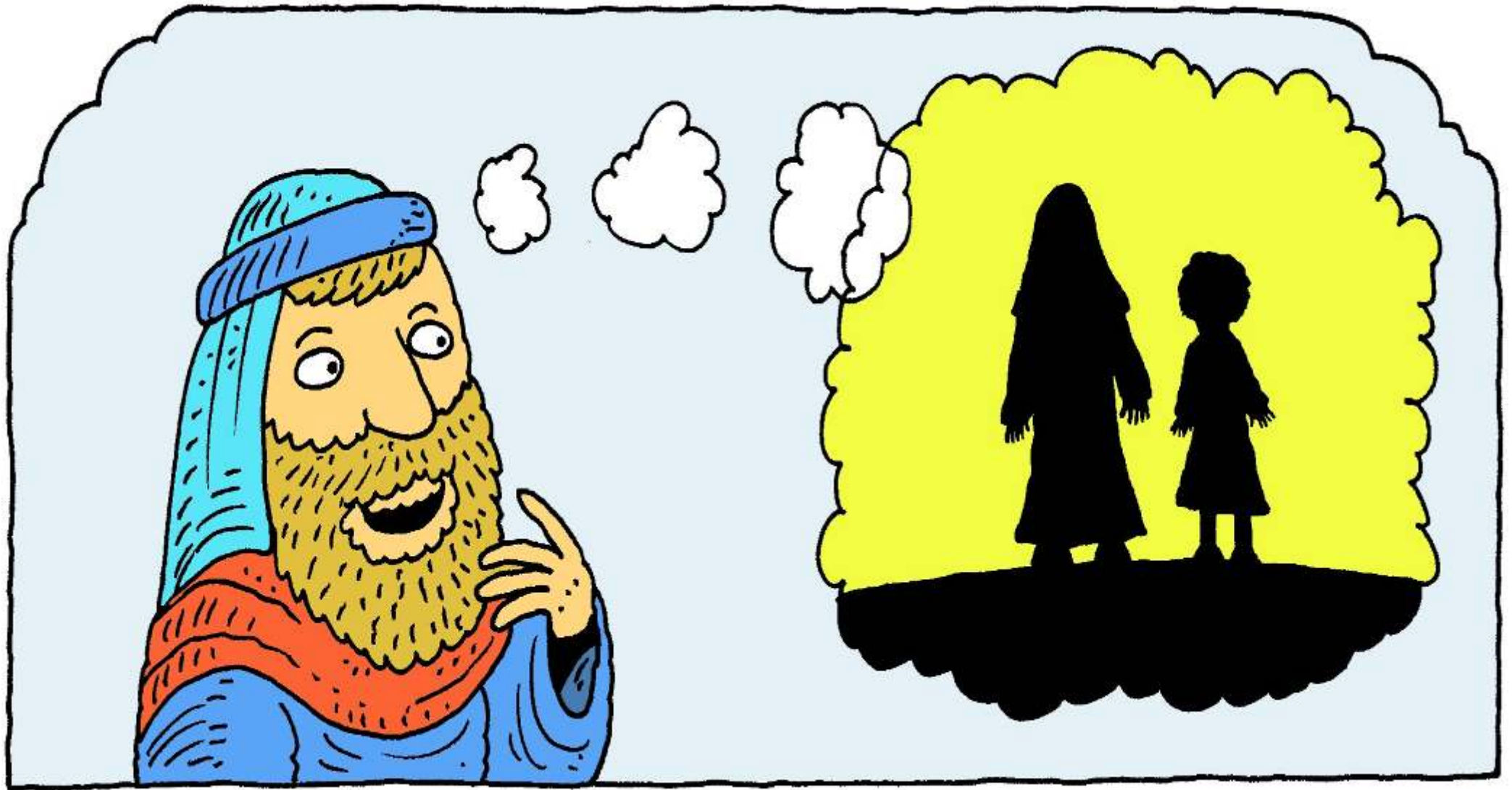


Elijah And The Widow

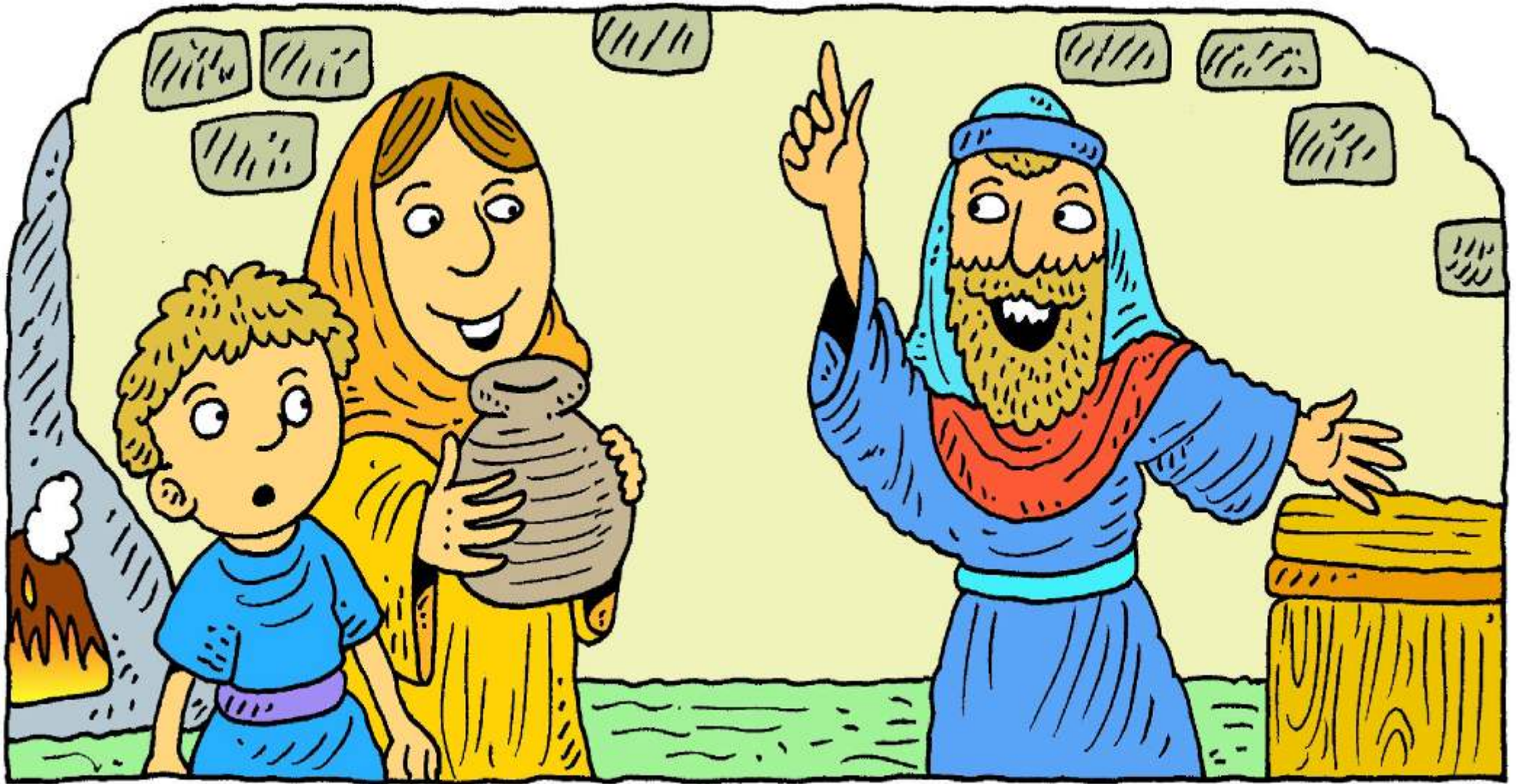
Elijah was hungry and thirsty.

and a little bread?” he asked.



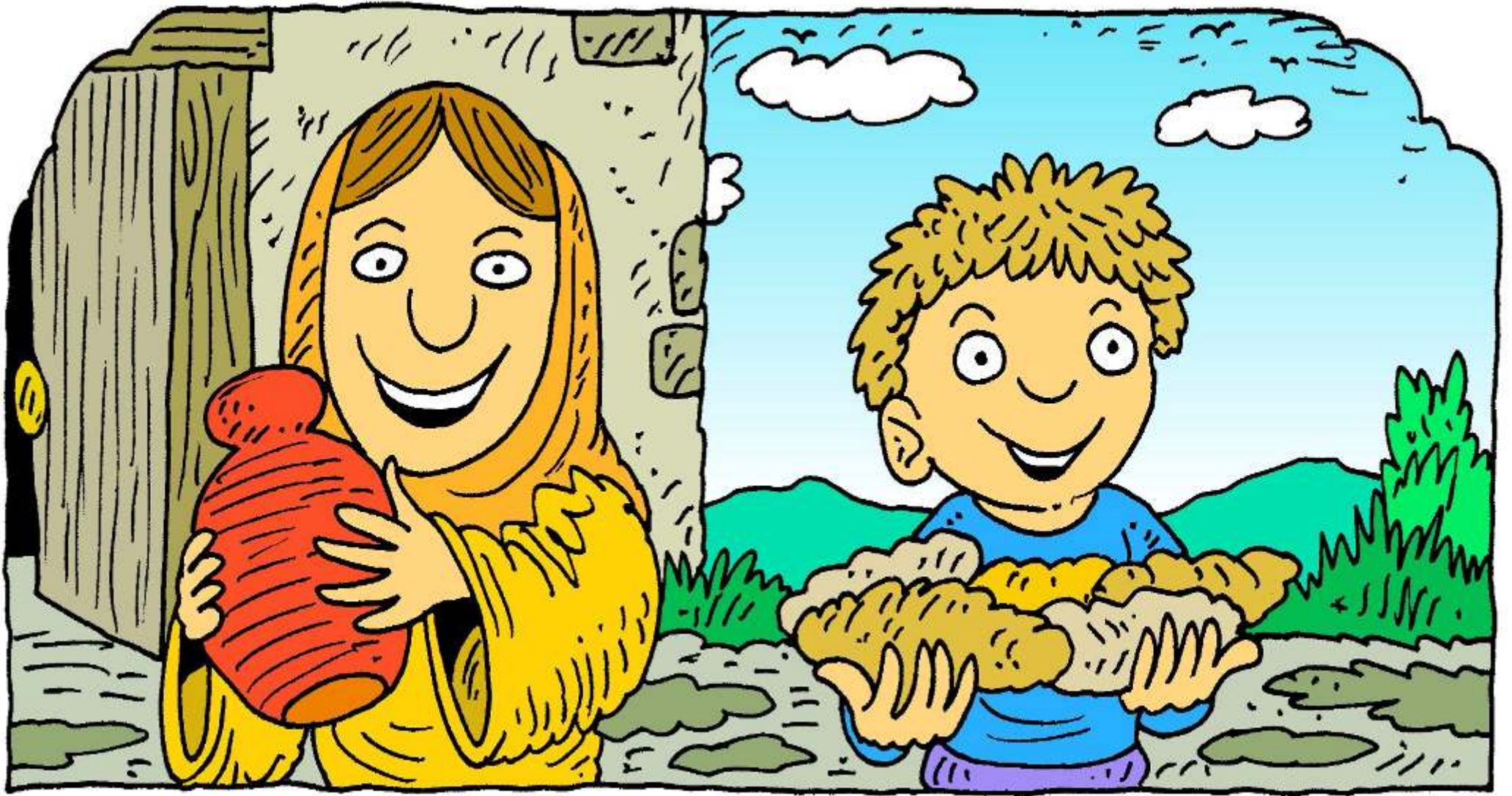
She said, "I only have a little flour and a little oil for one last bread roll."
"Cook one for me first and there will be enough for you both," he told her.



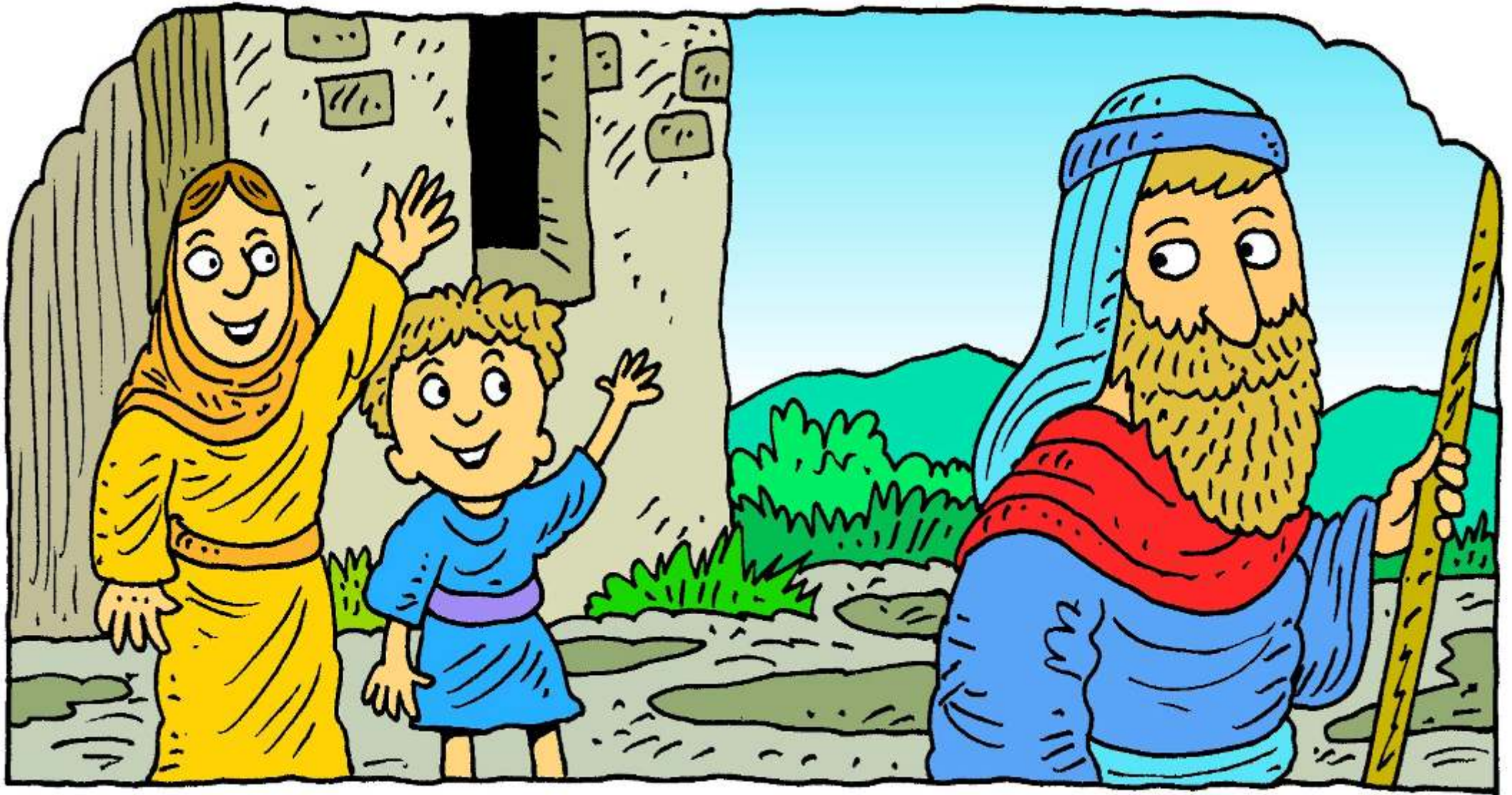
“Don’t worry.
