

Lesson N.T. 20 John The Baptist

Bible Stories: John the Baptist baptises Jesus
Matthew 3.

- 11. Smelly In The Belly Of A Whale – Jill Kemp Noah's Ark
- 15 . Make Me Like A Tree – Nigel Cato. Noah's Ark.
- 24. Caterpillar's surprise. Noah's Extra.

Props: butterfly & Caterpillar.

- "Here is the beehive" Finger rhyme from website

Verse

God wants us to listen and obey.
Joshua chapter 24 verse 24"

* Jesus did!

Show Verse book:

- Plus A Happy Heart is Good for you!

Show Big Book: John The Baptist.

This is a story about Jesus. He listened to and obeyed God.

*Talk about the story as you turn pages.

Use props to talk about the story:

* Make a big layered sandwich so children can have a turn chose to add something.

*John Baptist lived in a lonely place – no shops!

* **He ate locust and honey!**

Maybe he cooked locust on a fire!

Show plastic locust if possible.

*Where does honey come from?

Show Honey in comb (from Apiary) look at the wax holes the bees fill with honey.

* Bee prop. Bees make honey from flowers – show books, flower etc.

*Show flower

* Do Finger play: use glove with bees (laminated pictures etc on fingers.)

- Here is a Beehive Rhyme adapted:

“John The Baptist Finds Honey” – adapted by Jill Kemp
Make fist with bees tucked away.

Start with little finger out one at a time: 1,2,3,4,5

*People came to hear John the Baptist talking about God. He said, “God wants us to do what is good and right.” Some people said they were sorry for not being good. They wanted to change and start being good.

They went to the river. Said a “sorry to God” prayer and put their head right under the water and came straight up – to show they were going to love God and do good and right.

- From now on they wanted to follow God.
- That is called being baptized.

Jesus wanted to be baptized,

- John said “You are too good and I am not good enough to do up your shoes.”
- Jesus said, “It is the right thing to do.”
- So John baptized Jesus in the river.

- Have a cardboard waves with Jesus on a stick goes down and up.
- NEVER demonstrate using doll and bath with little children – they may baptize a sibling in the bath!
- * A dove came down and God said. “This is my Son I am happy with him.”
- Now read book.
- Using a mirror, say every child’s name – “Who does Jesus love? Billy! etc”
- Pray

*Write name on back shape in marking pen.

The children put **activity, book and beehive rhyme** on table by door.

Morning tea. Roll while eating it.
