*Book – The Silly Greedy Farmer – By Jill Kemp

*Show Globe of world and how the world turns around the sun – some people on the other side of the world are sleeping in the dark when we are awake!

* Show Children Of World wheel on stick so it turns. (Children do this as activity to take home.)
Talk about different cultures looking different.

*Tell story **Suli is Sad** – By Jill Kemp using boy puppet with marks on face.

- A Warrior Chief's son had a baby boy. He was proud. "I will call him Suli," said the Chief. "In our language it means "Strong For God." Little Suli had bad marks on his face but his family loved him so much they hardly even noticed. (Show puppet.)
- Suli's Dad wanted to be a doctor and everyone in his family worked together growing and selling bananas. It was hot, hard work.
- But the day came when his Dad was to go to a far away country to learn to be a Doctor, so he could help his people when they got sick.
- Suli was going to with him too! Then he could go to a good school and learn English. Suli was so proud. "Remember to be strong for God," said the Chief to Suli. "Stand tall, be proud and remember you are the son of a Chief."
- On the first day at his new school a big boy asked, "What's your name Ugly face?" Suli looked at the ground and tried to hide his marked face. "Suli" he whispered.
- "Silly! Silly What a silly name Ugly Face! " All the other children laughed and chanted "Silly Ugly Face."

- A tear ran down Suli's cheek.
- "Baby, Baby, Silly, Ugly Face," chanted the children.
- But one little boy was kind. He remembered that Jesus wants us to be kind.
- "Suli, come and play," he said. Soon the two boys were laughing and having fun.
- The teacher had been watching. At mat time she asked Suli to come up the front of the class. Poor Suli pulled his hat low over his face to hide his marks and kept his eyes on the floor.
