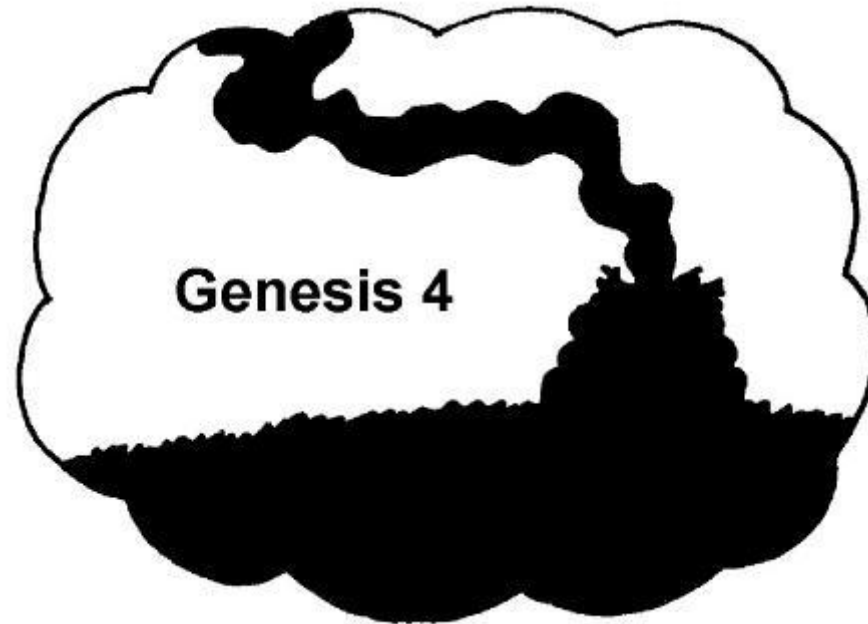
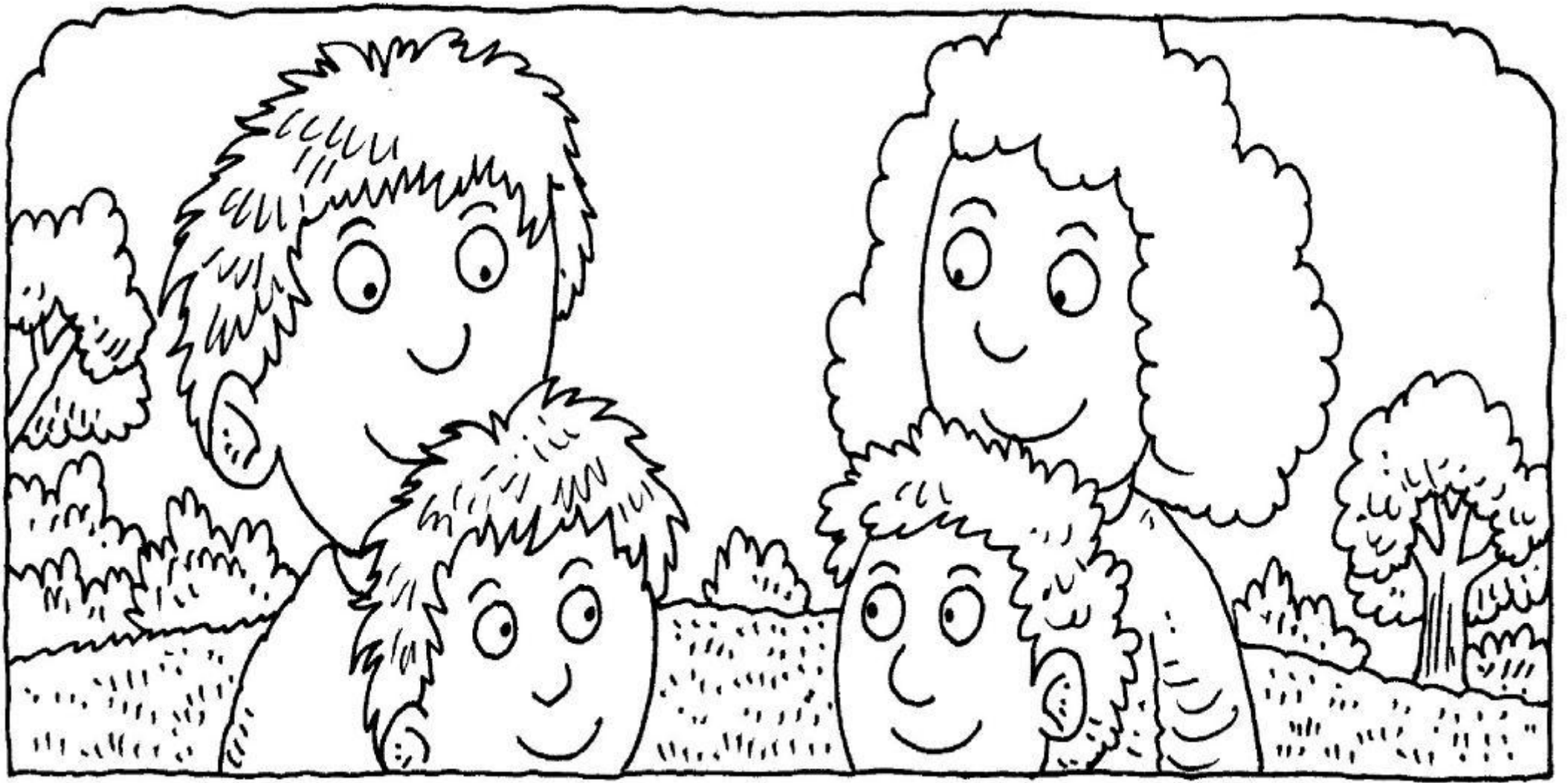


Cain And Abel

first Cain and then Abel.

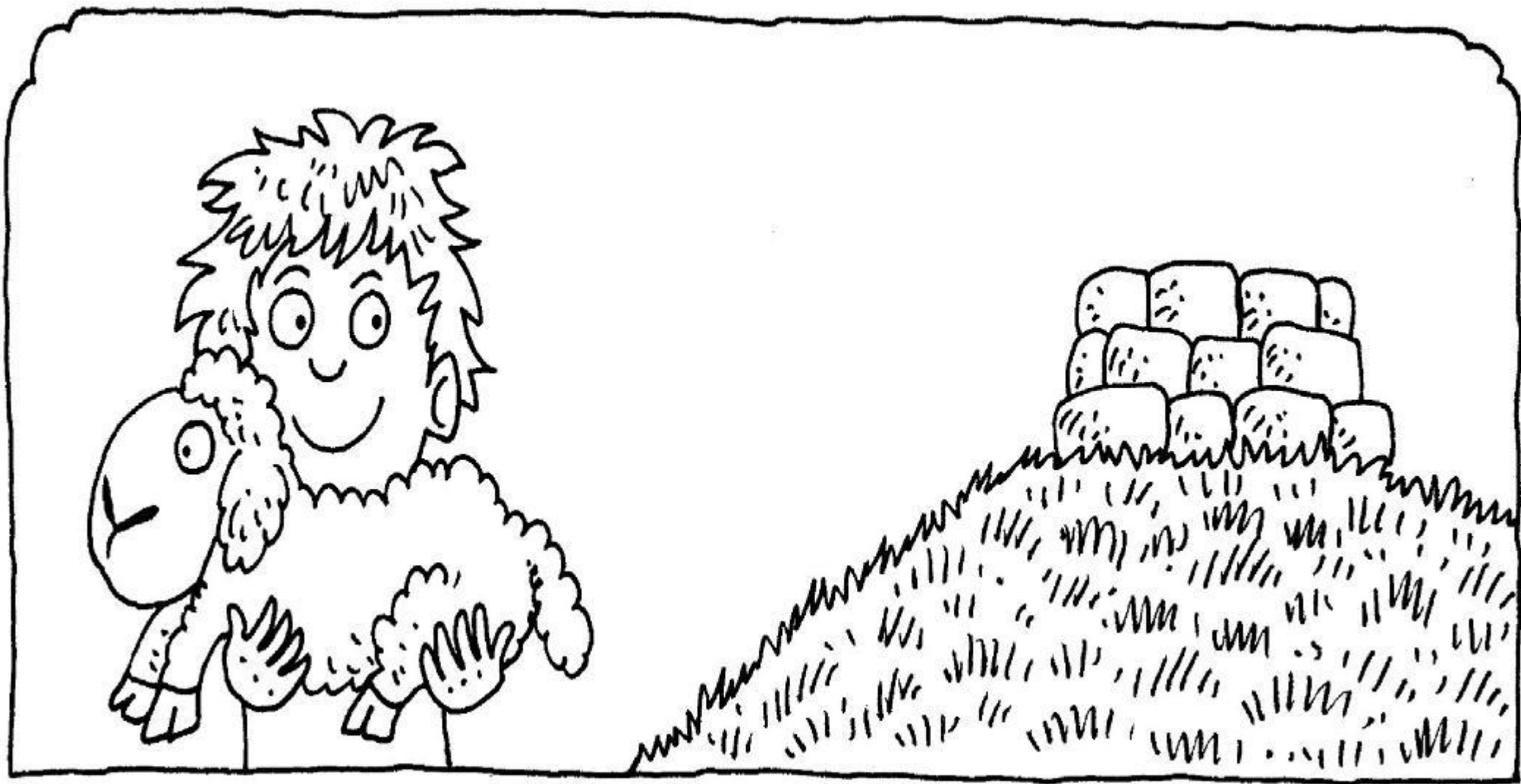


Cain loved to grow vegetables,

and weeding the garden.

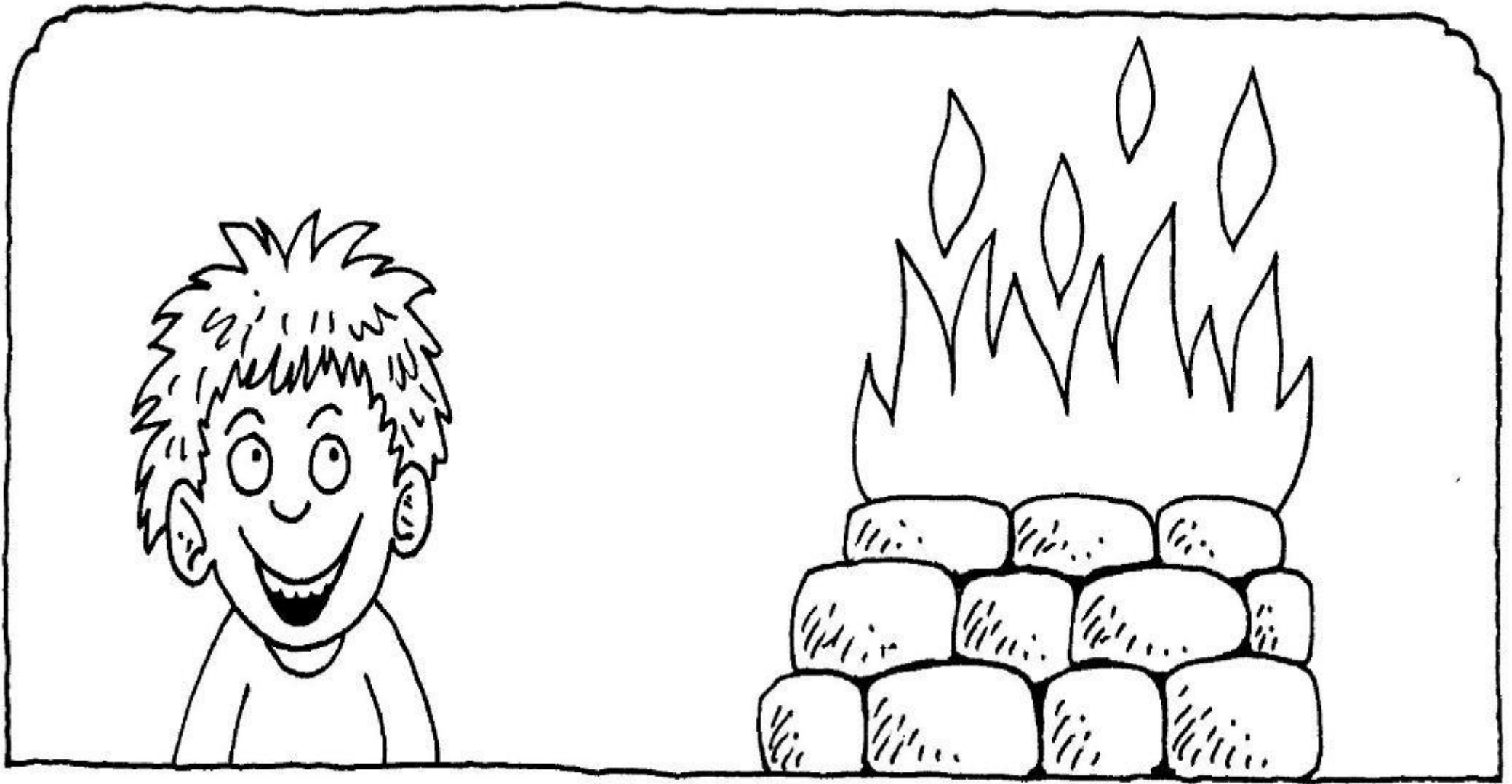


He brought the first of all

as a gift to God.

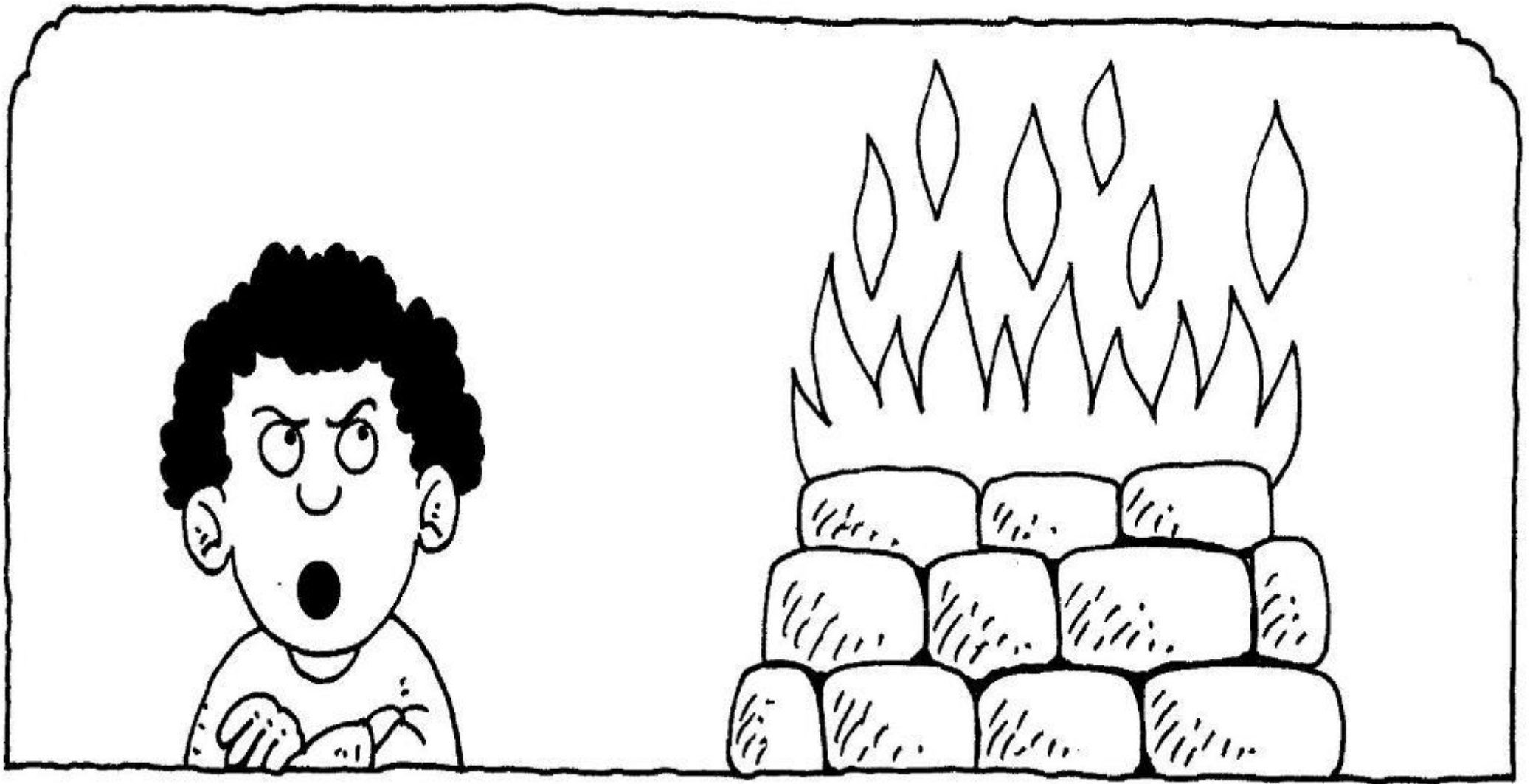
“I will show God what I can do,” he thought.



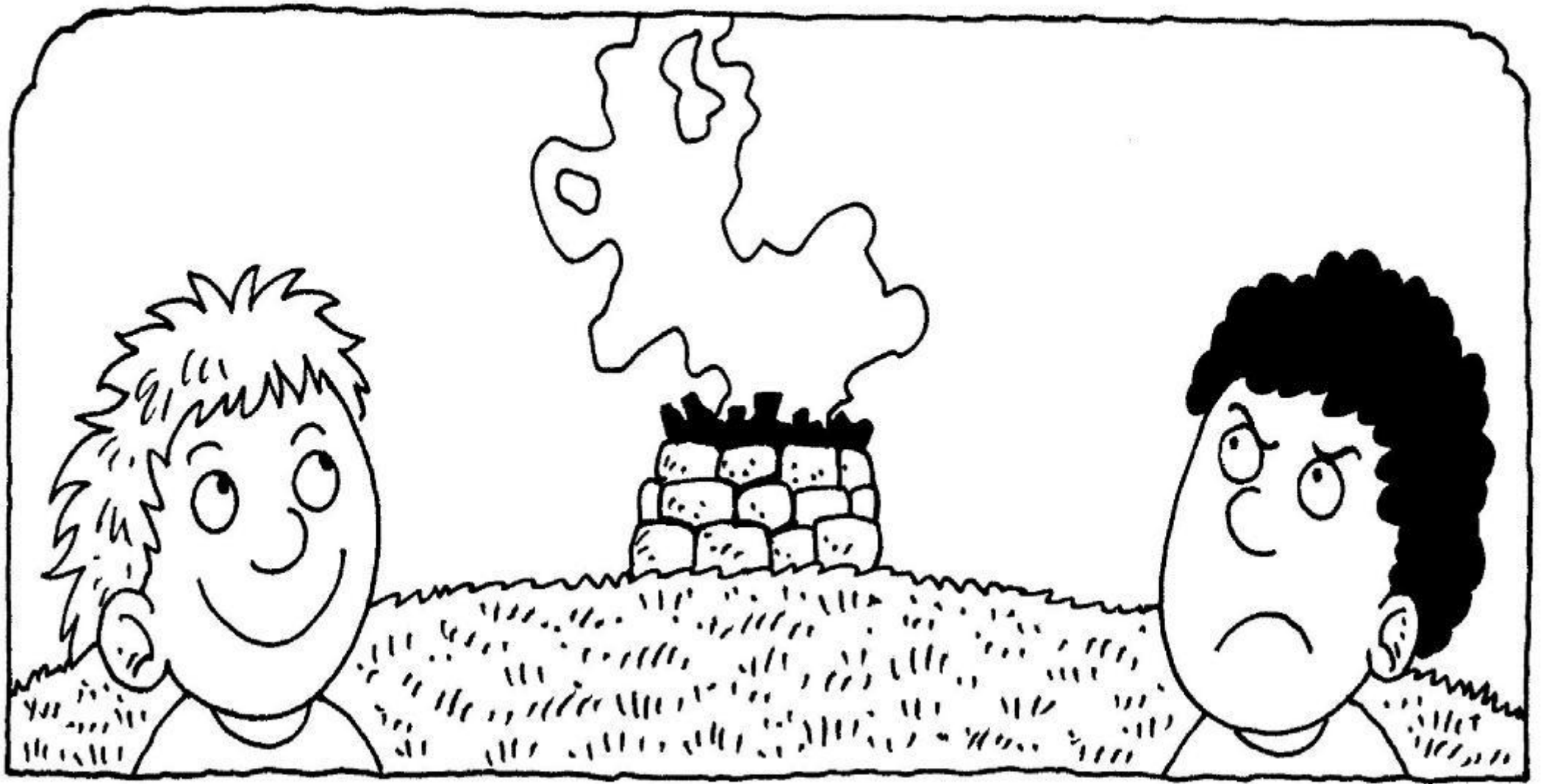
Abel looked after the sheep.
