

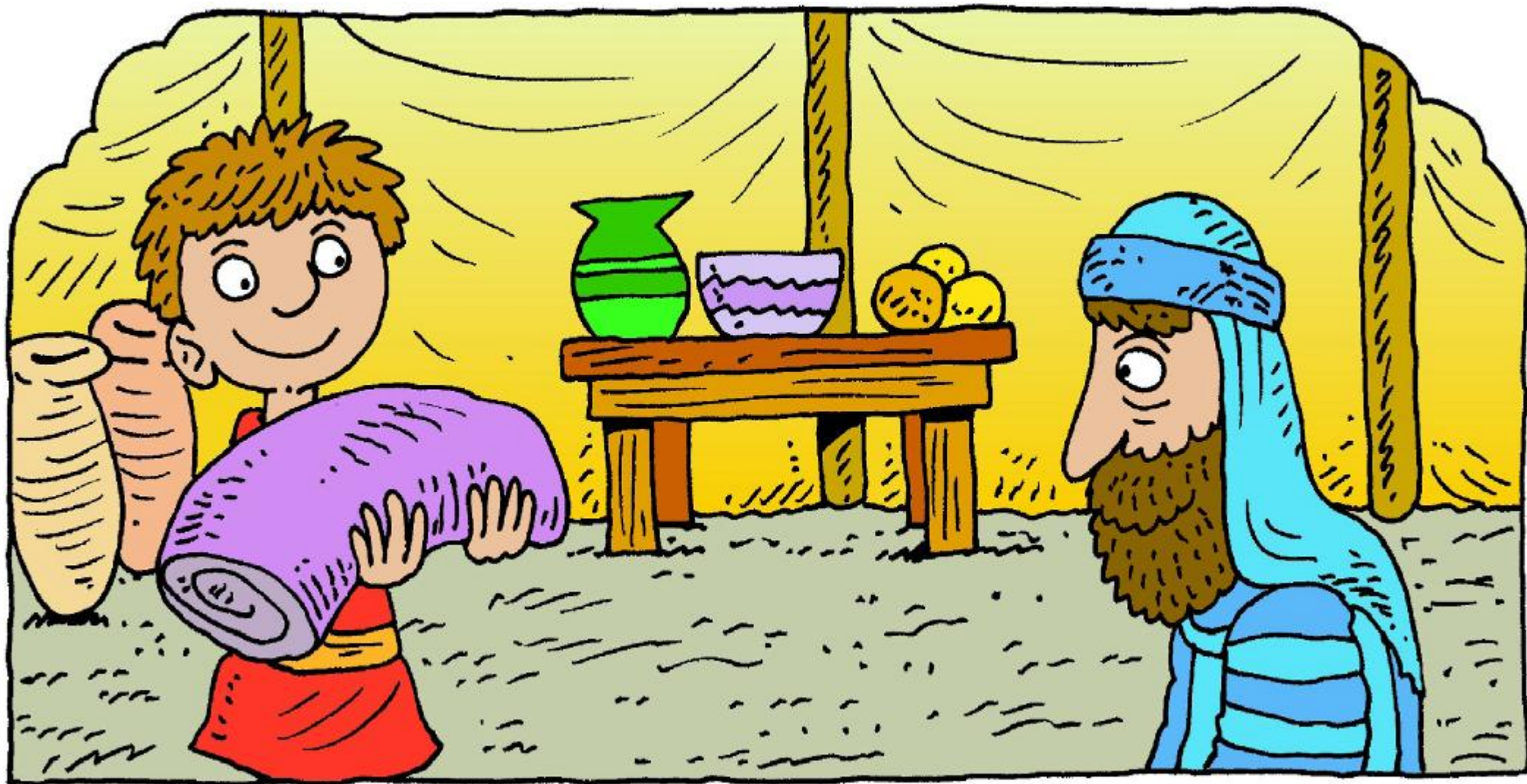
Samuel Hears From God

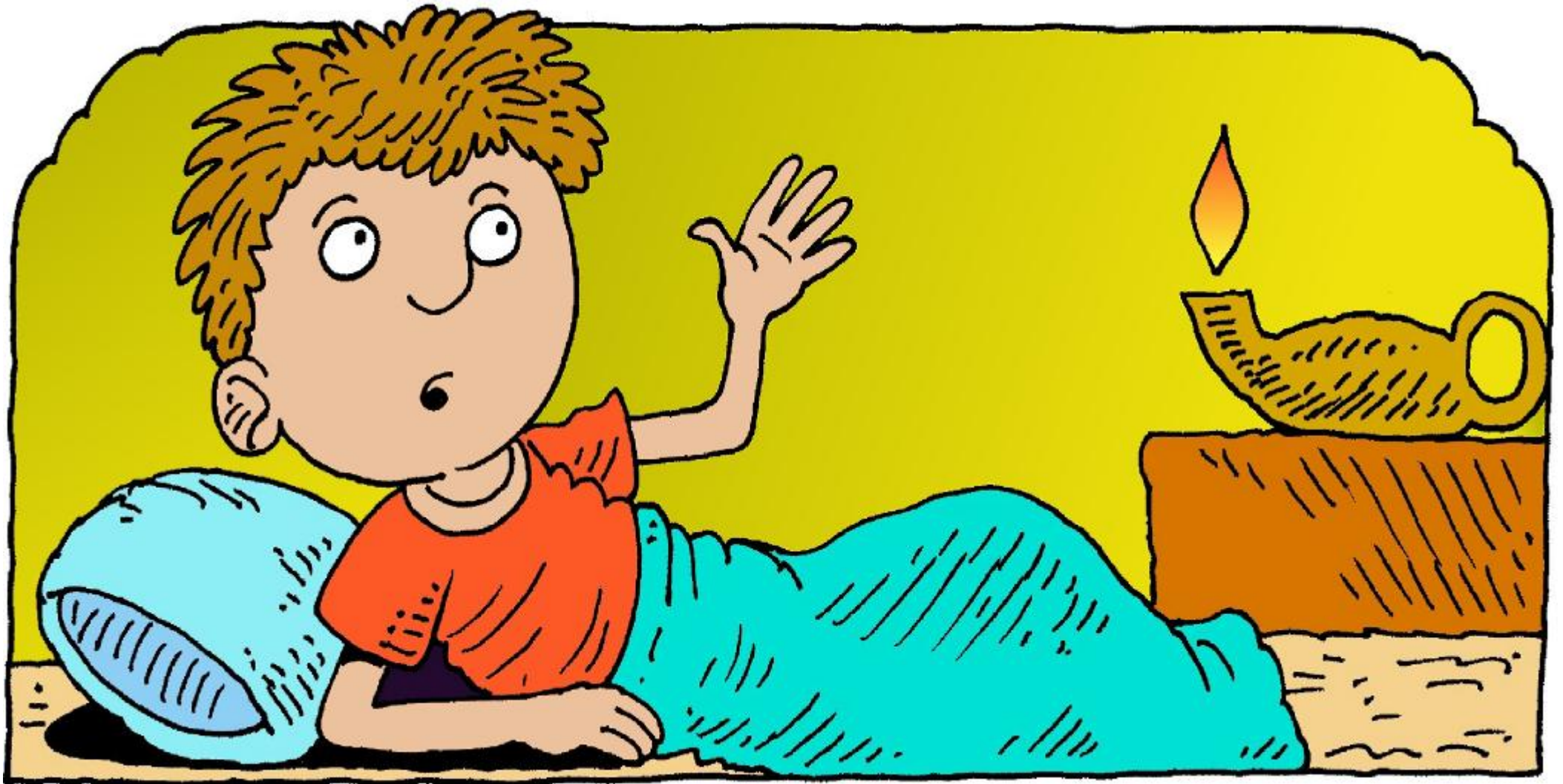

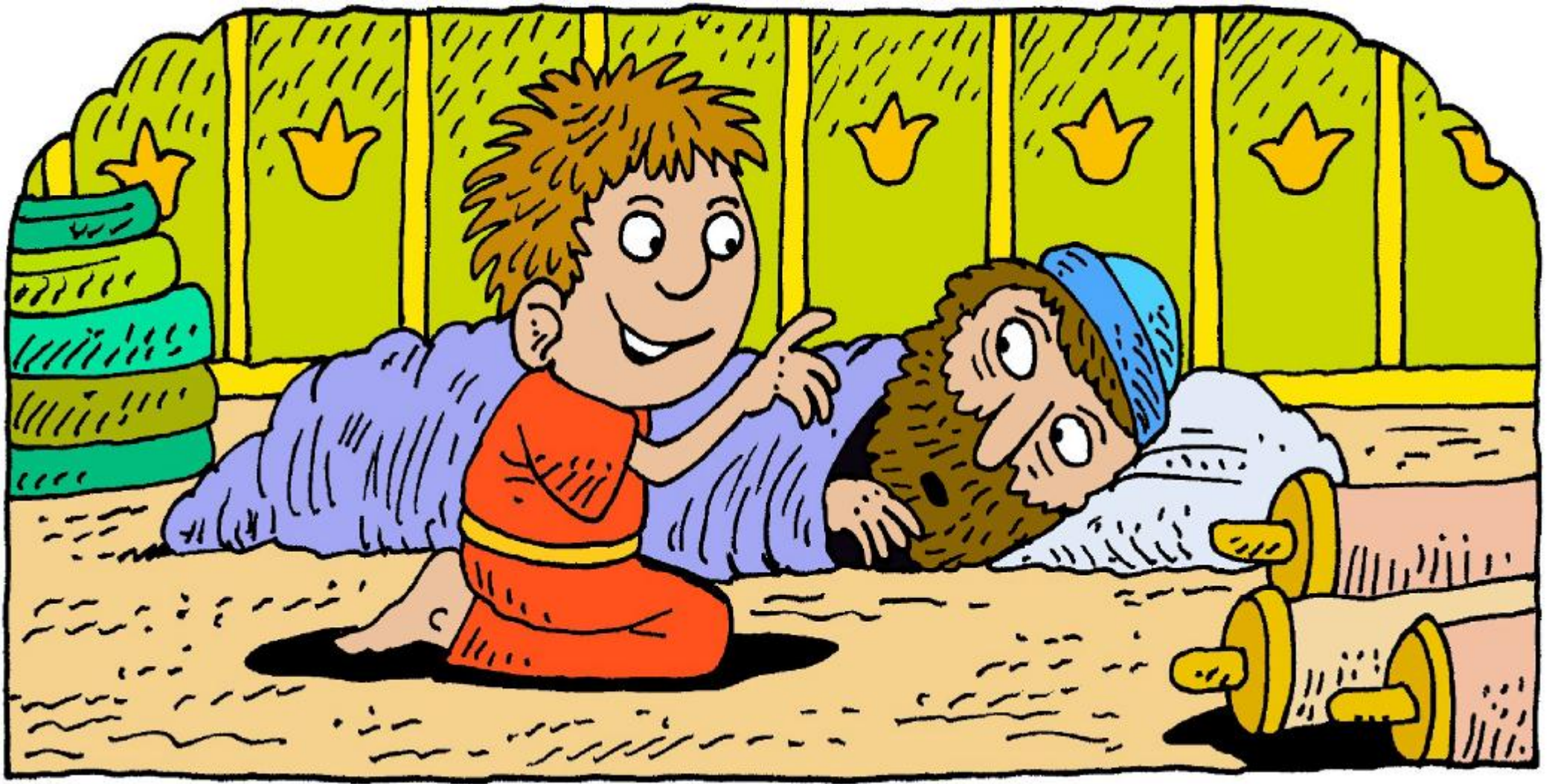
When Hannah asked God for a baby she made a promise to give her child to God.

“Eli I am here,” said Samuel.

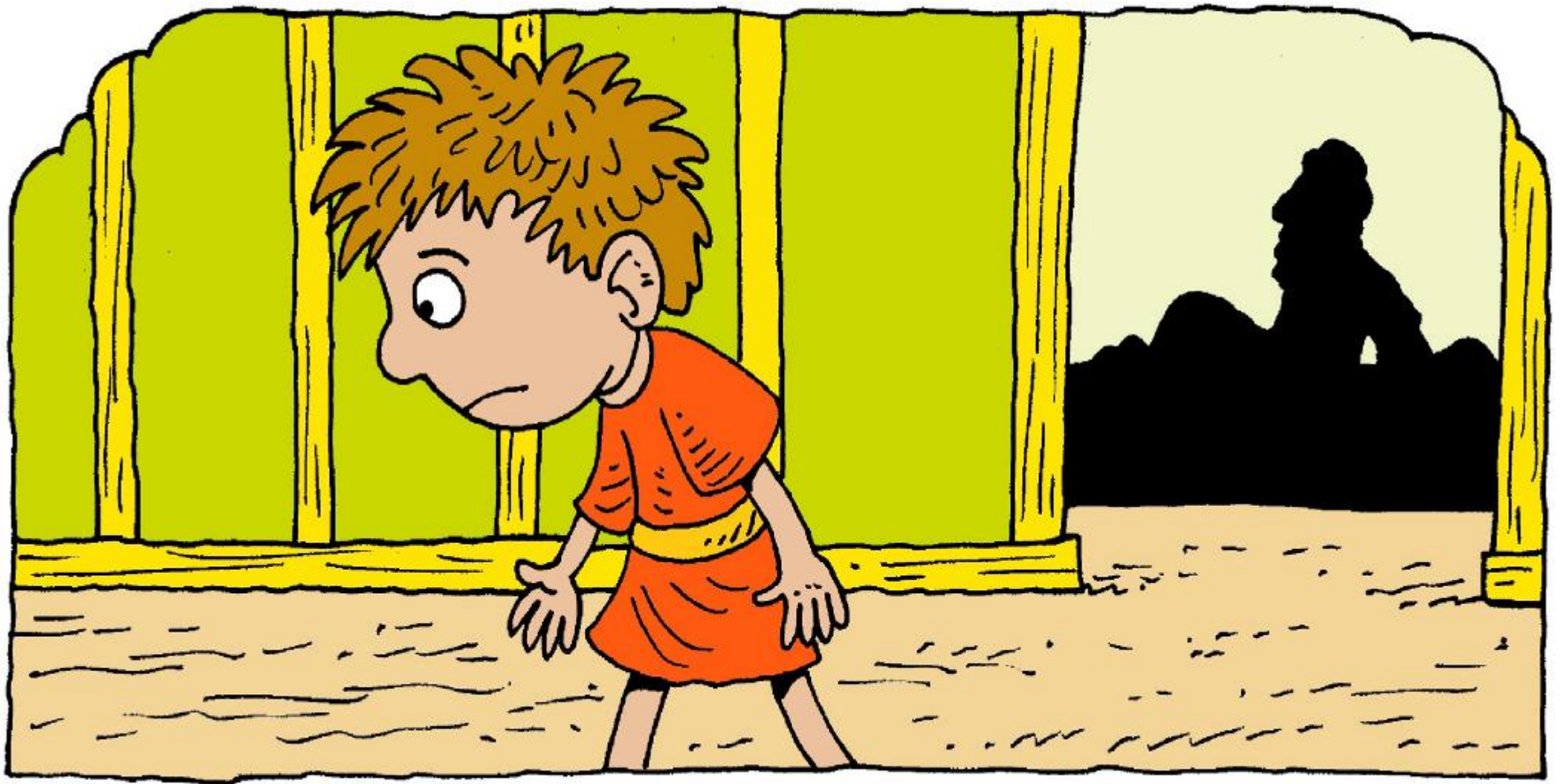
“Do you want me?”

“No, Samuel, I didn’t call you.”

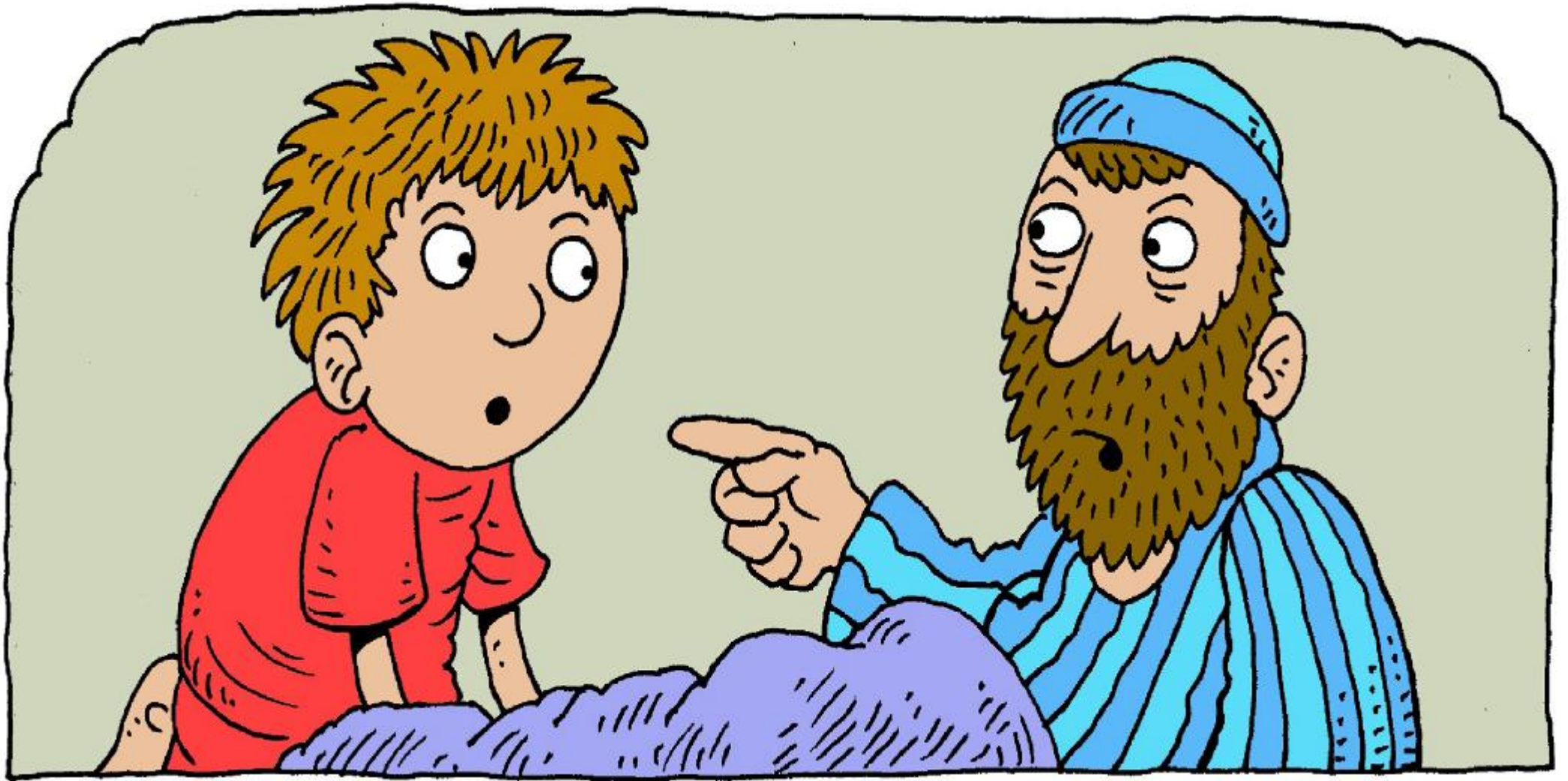
Samuel didn’t know it was God calling his name.



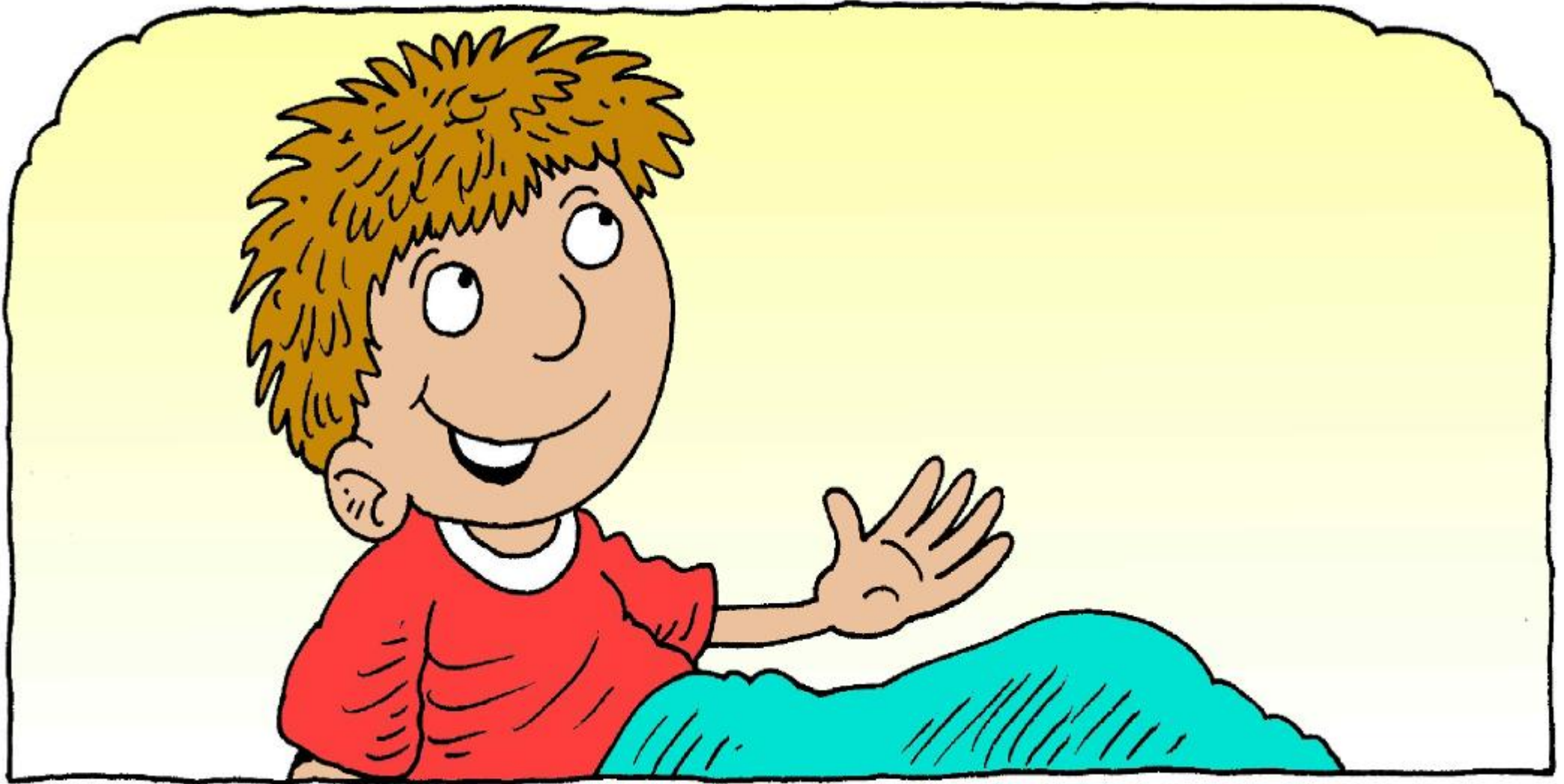
He lay down in his bed and
