

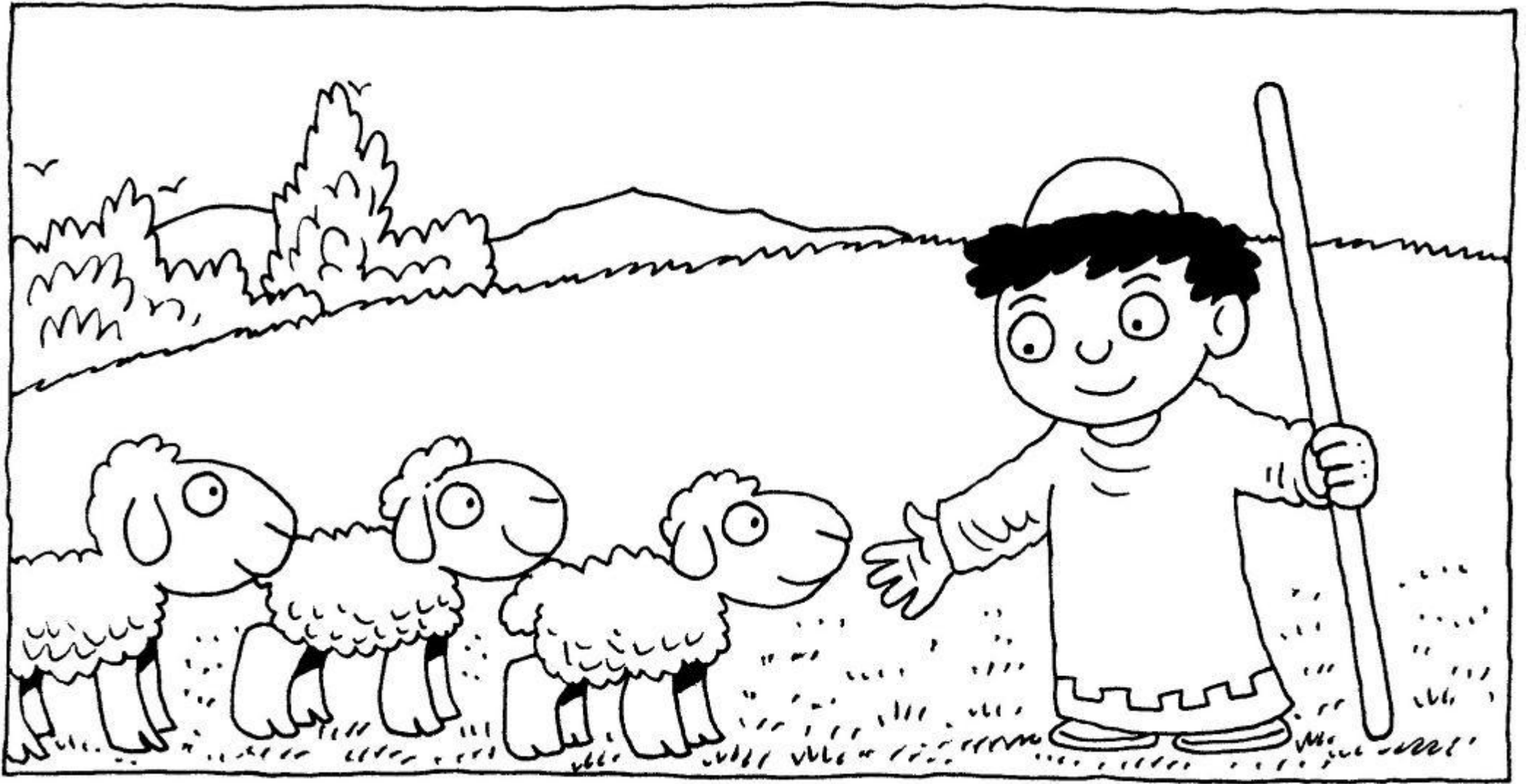
I Am A Little Shepherd Boy

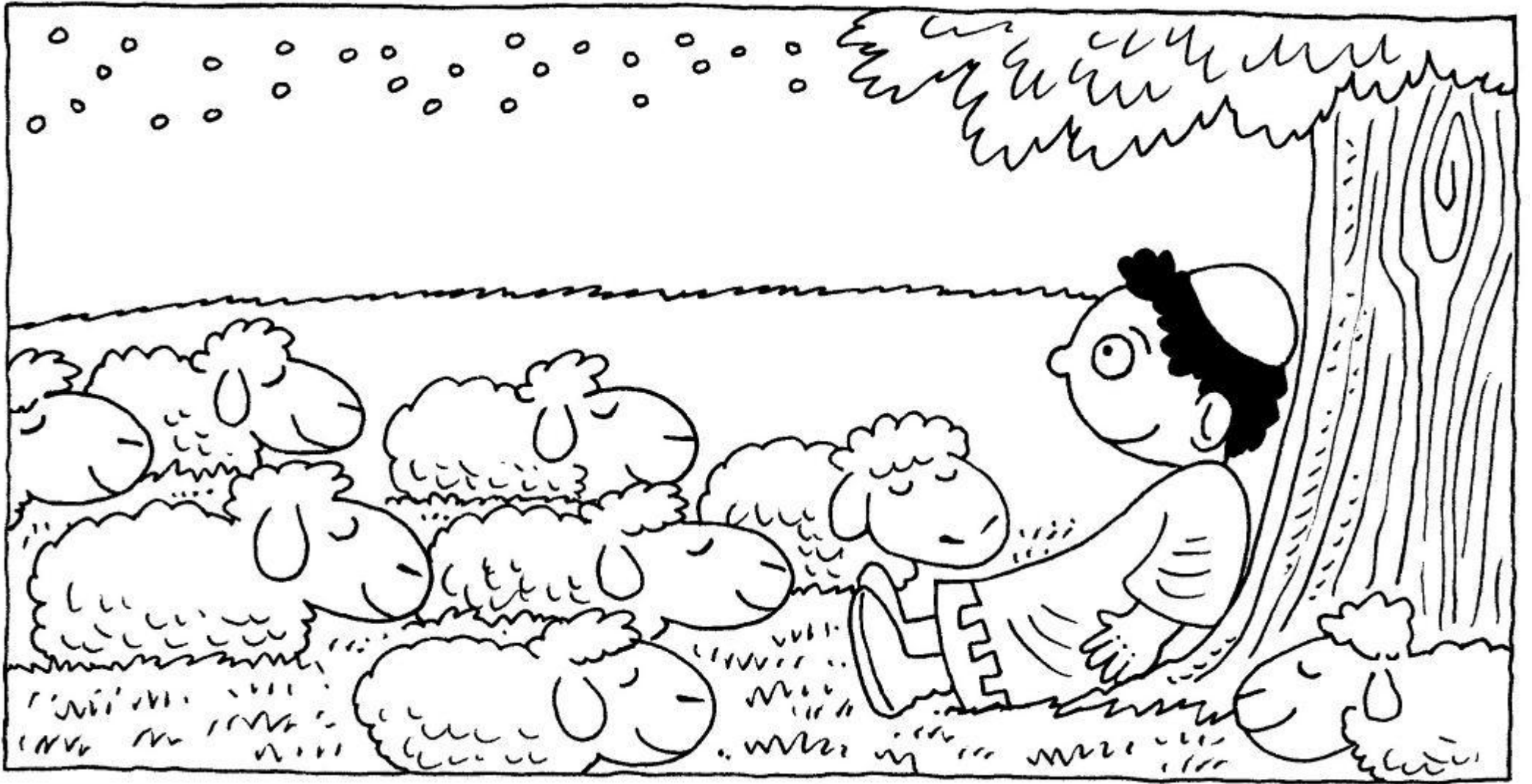

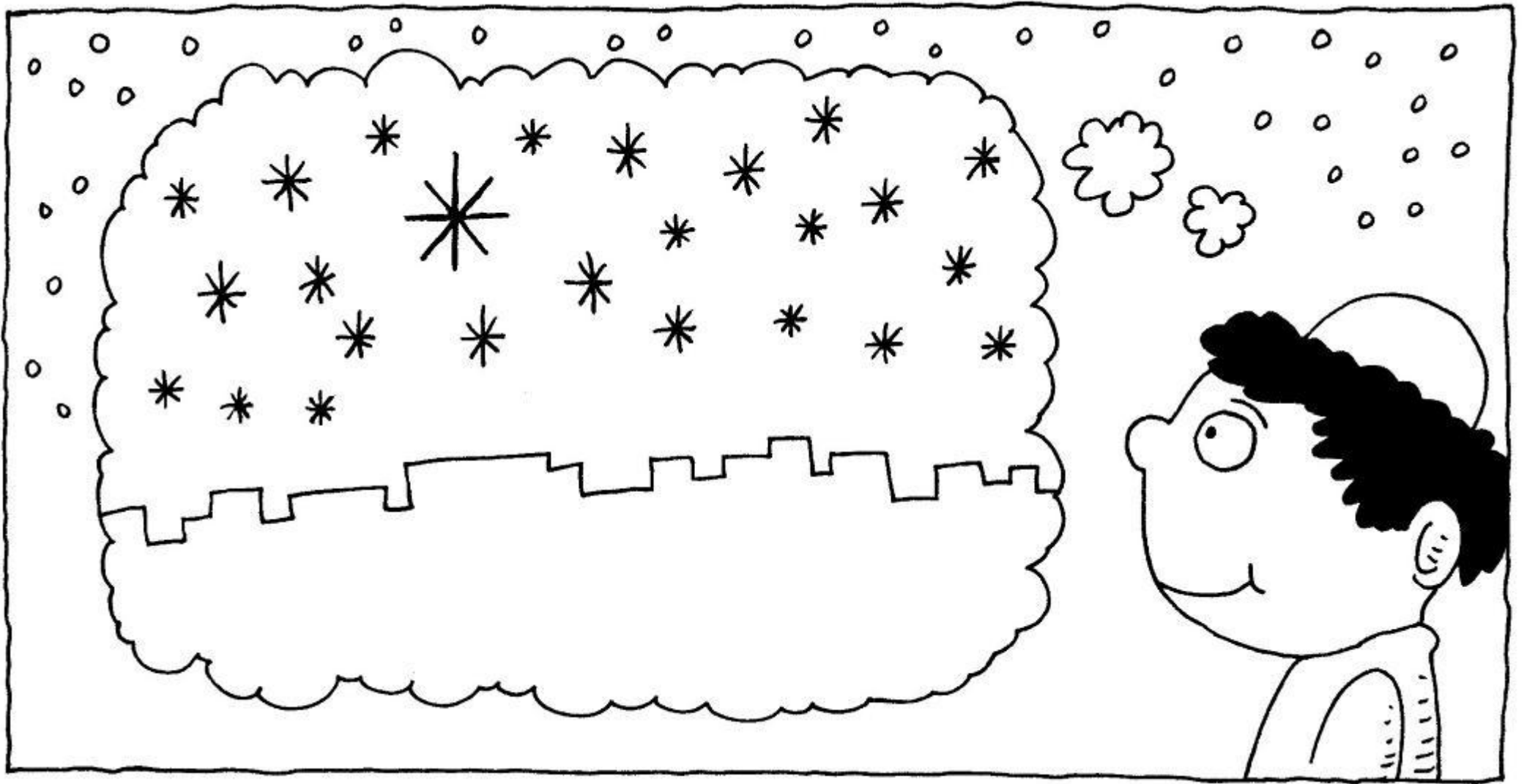
The night that Jesus was born,

I look after all my sheep.



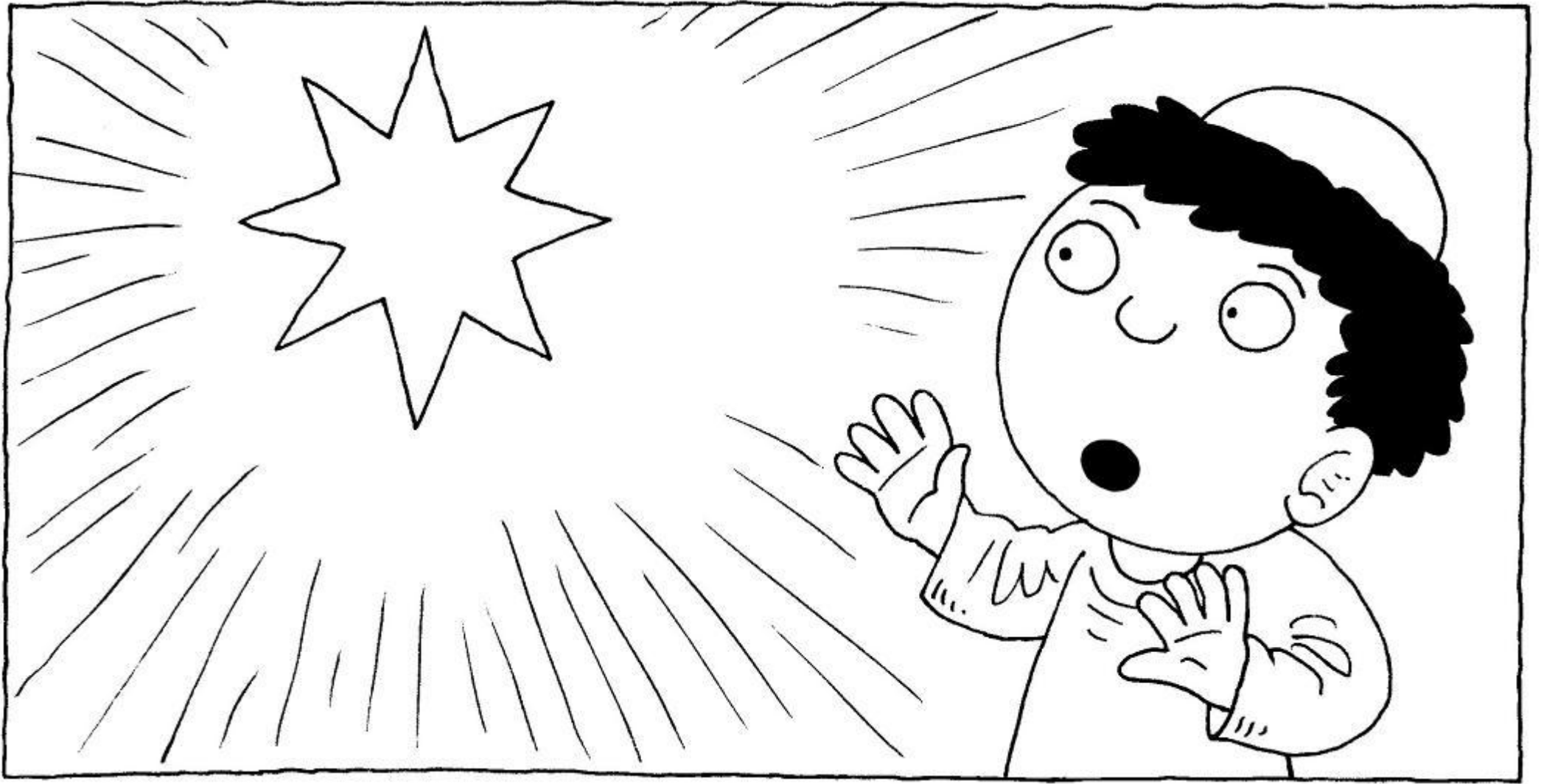
I watch over them

when Jesus Christ was born.



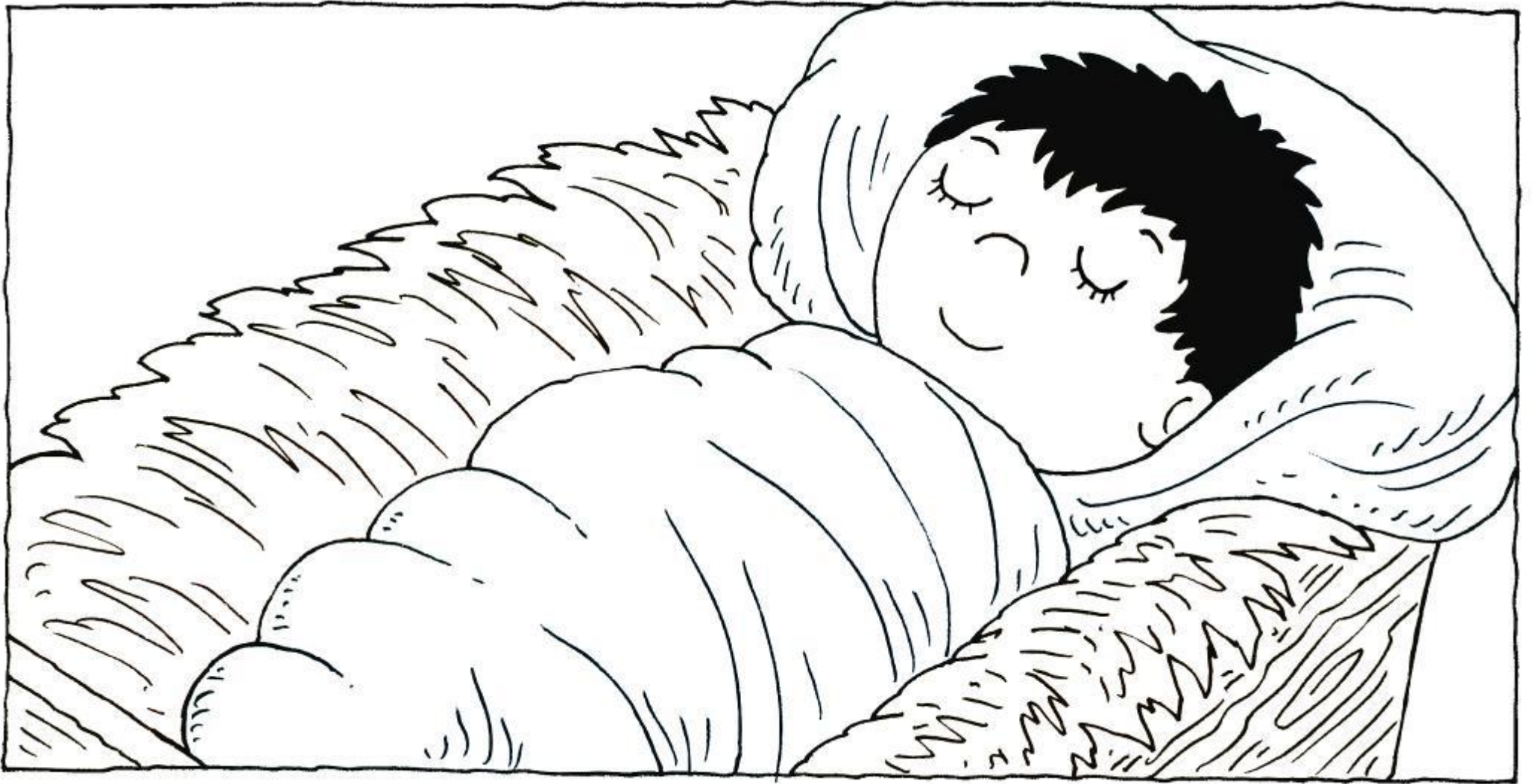
The biggest star I ever saw

all shining and so bright.



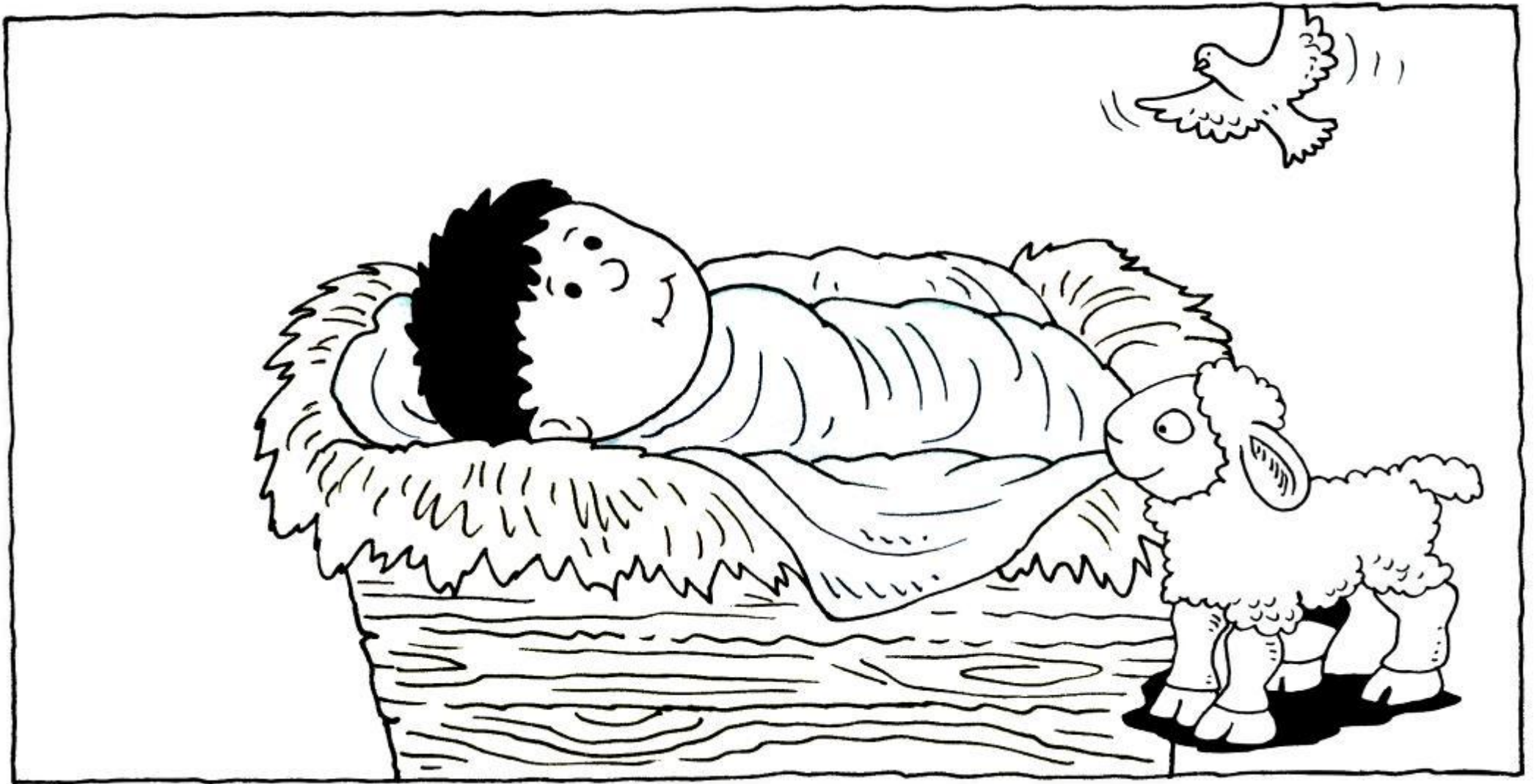
“Don't get a fright,” the angel said,
