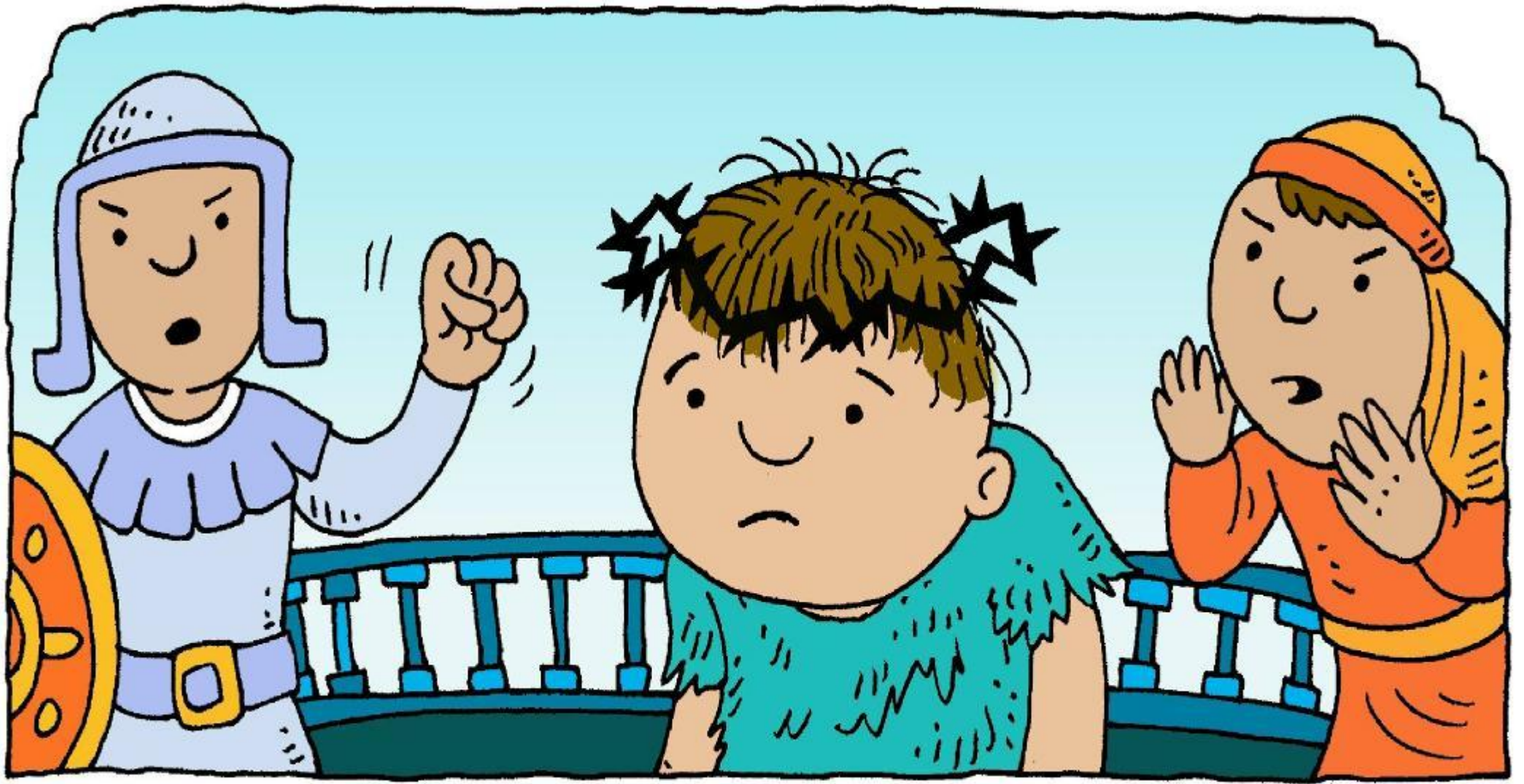
At the very first Easter

And took Jesus away.



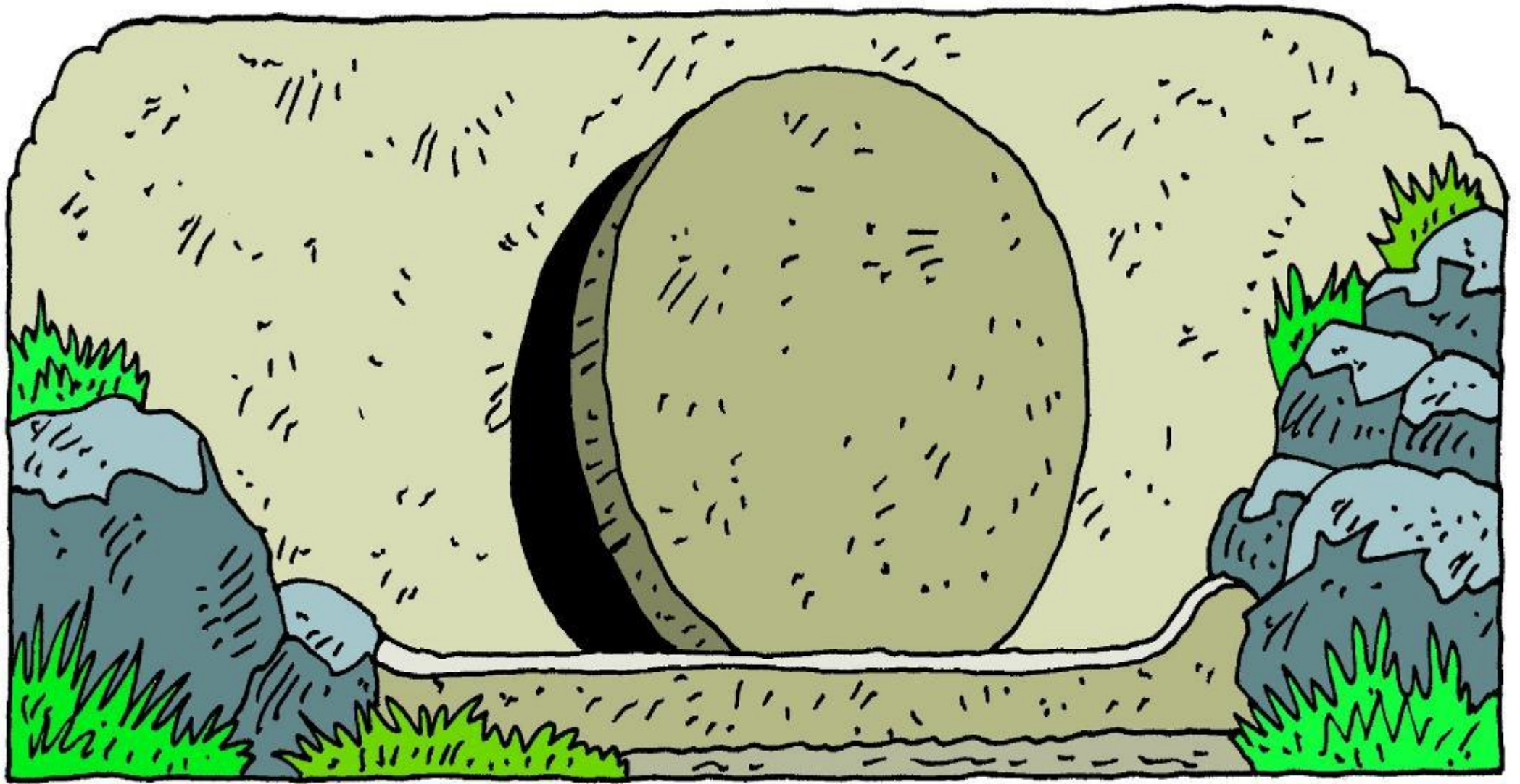
At the very first Easter

That God was his dad!



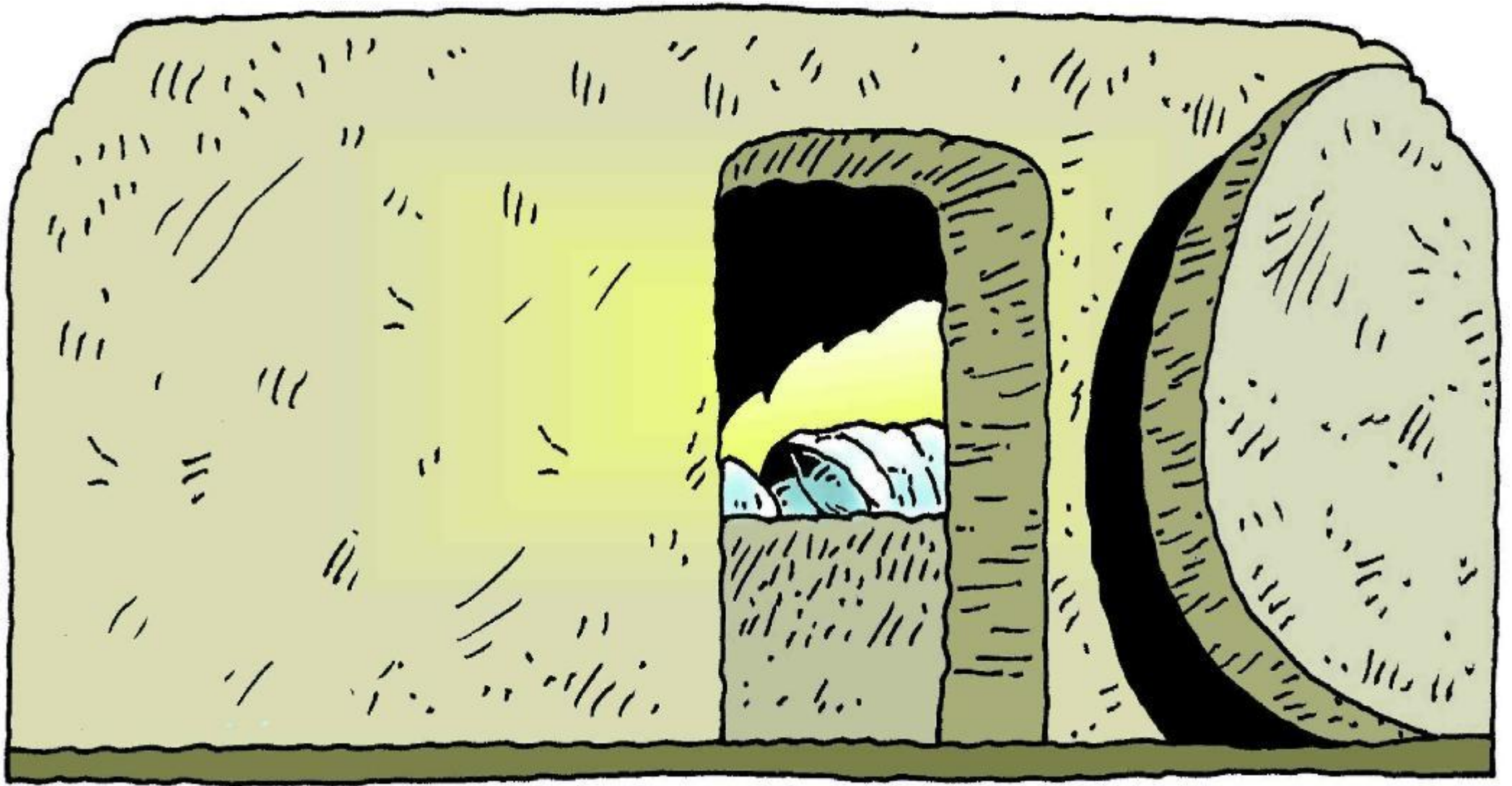
At the very first Easter

A crown of thorns.



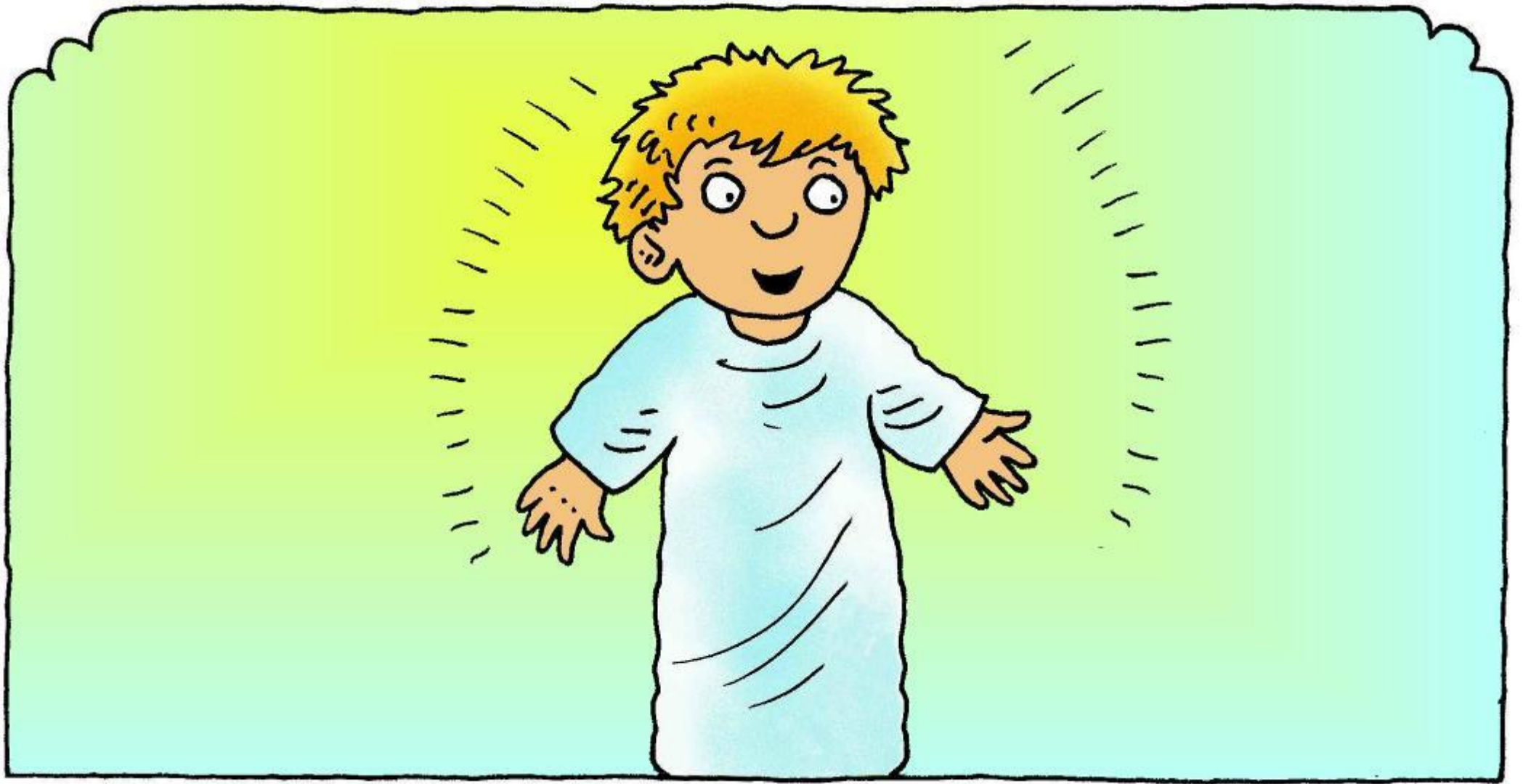
At the very first Easter
