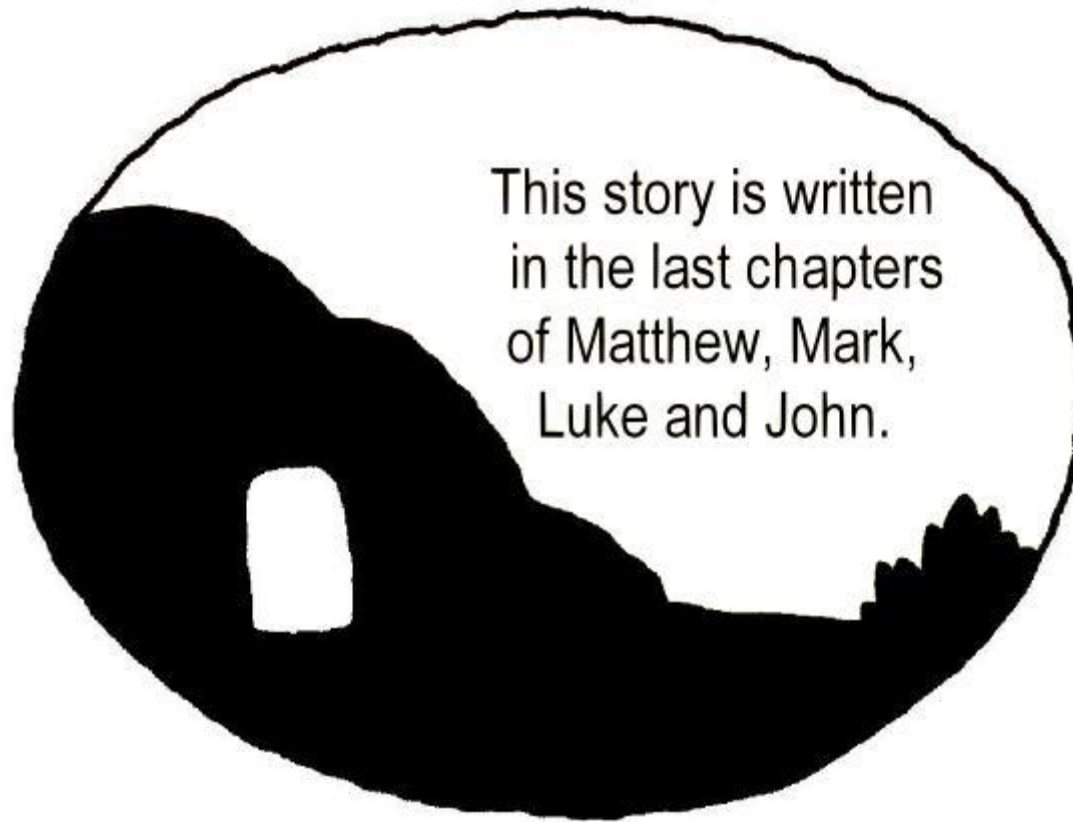


Easter Story

They listened to his stories about God.



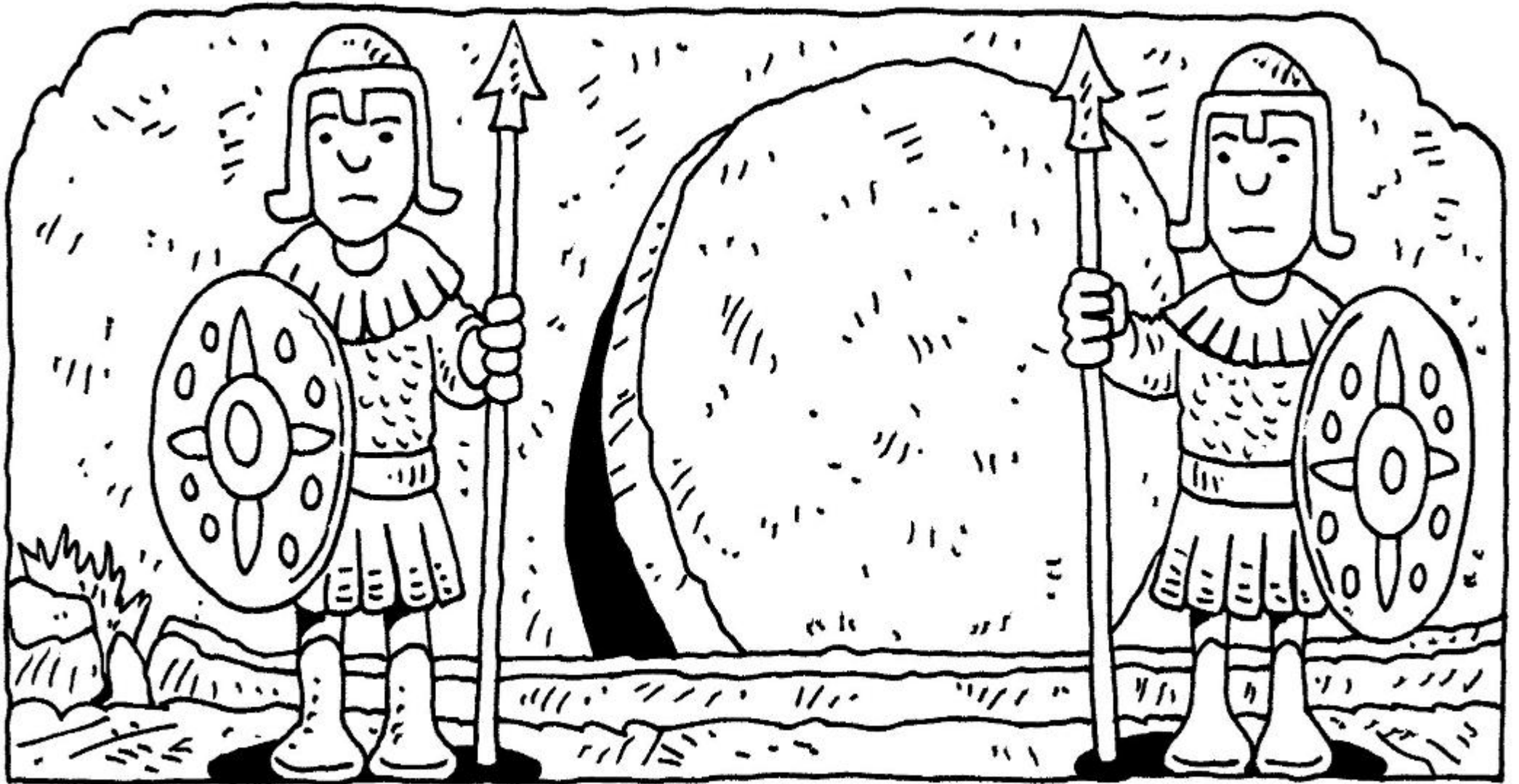
One day Jesus said to them,

but I will come back again.”



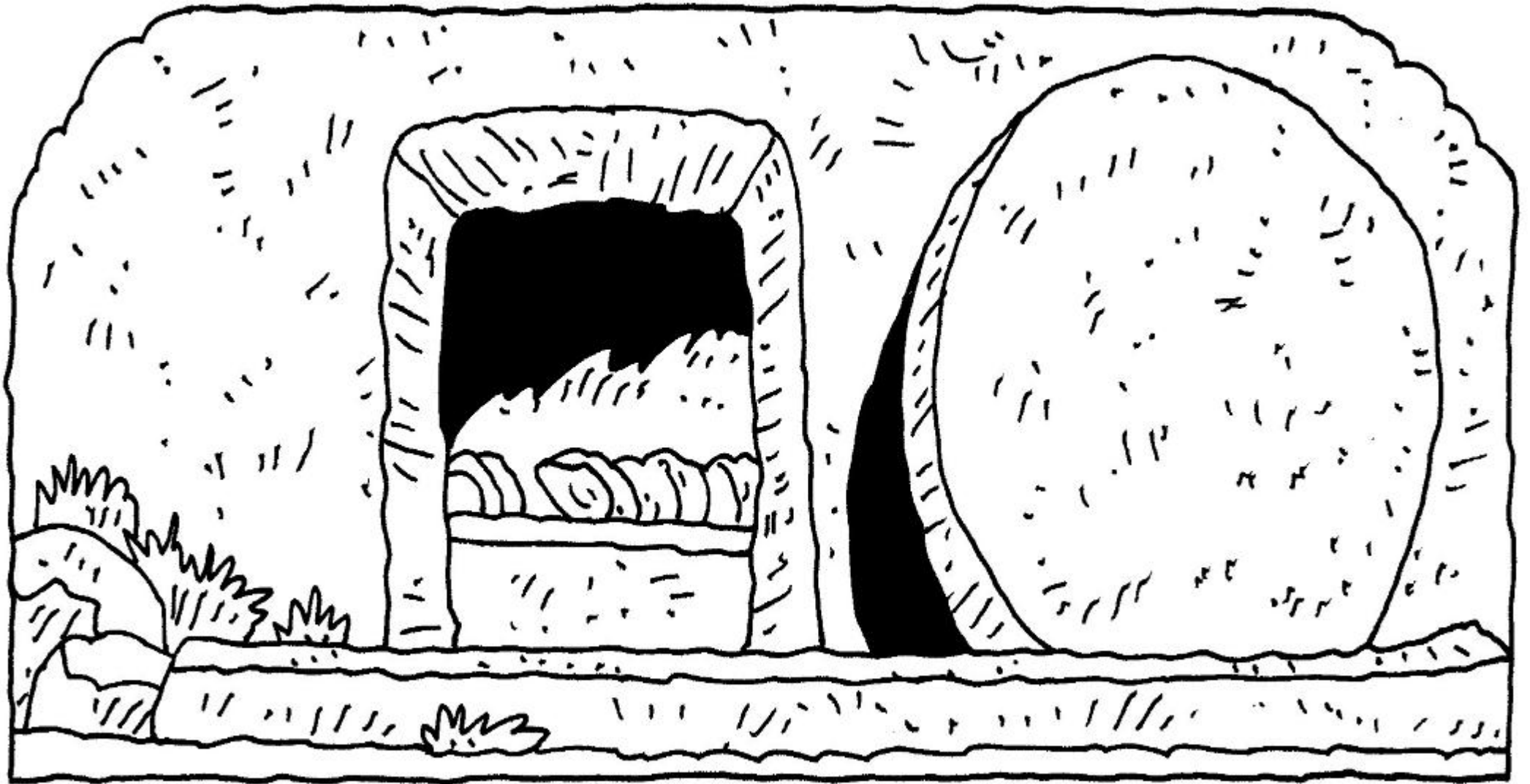
Jesus went into the garden to pray.
