who are sick and hungry.



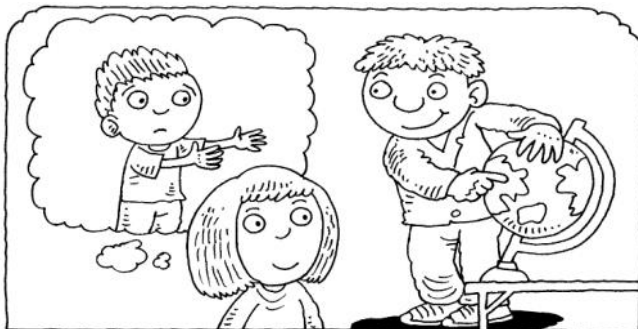
When I hear on the news

to pay for a plane ticket.



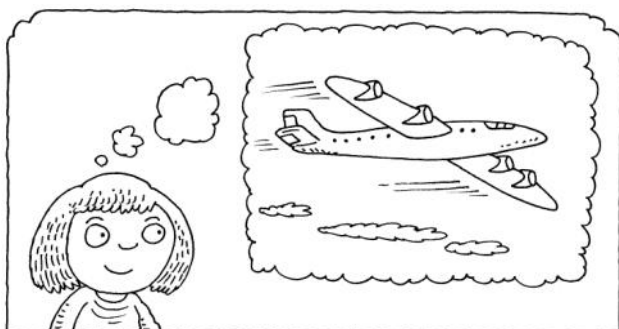
I can pray for missionaries

other ways that I can help.



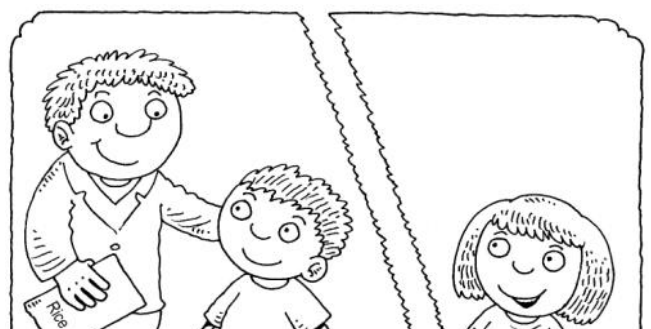
A missionary showed us
