He aha koe i tītiro ai?

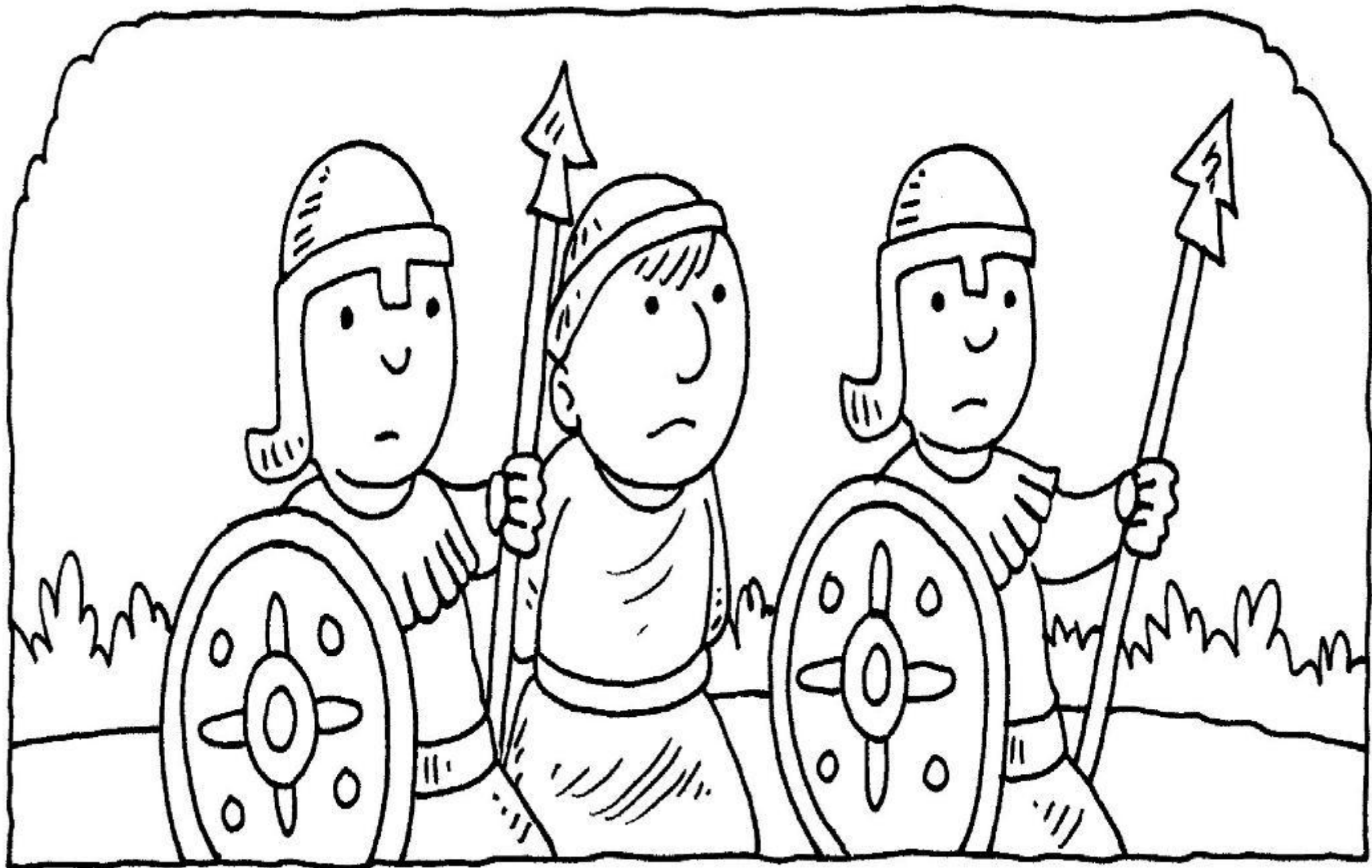
what would you see?

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kua riri ngā tangata,

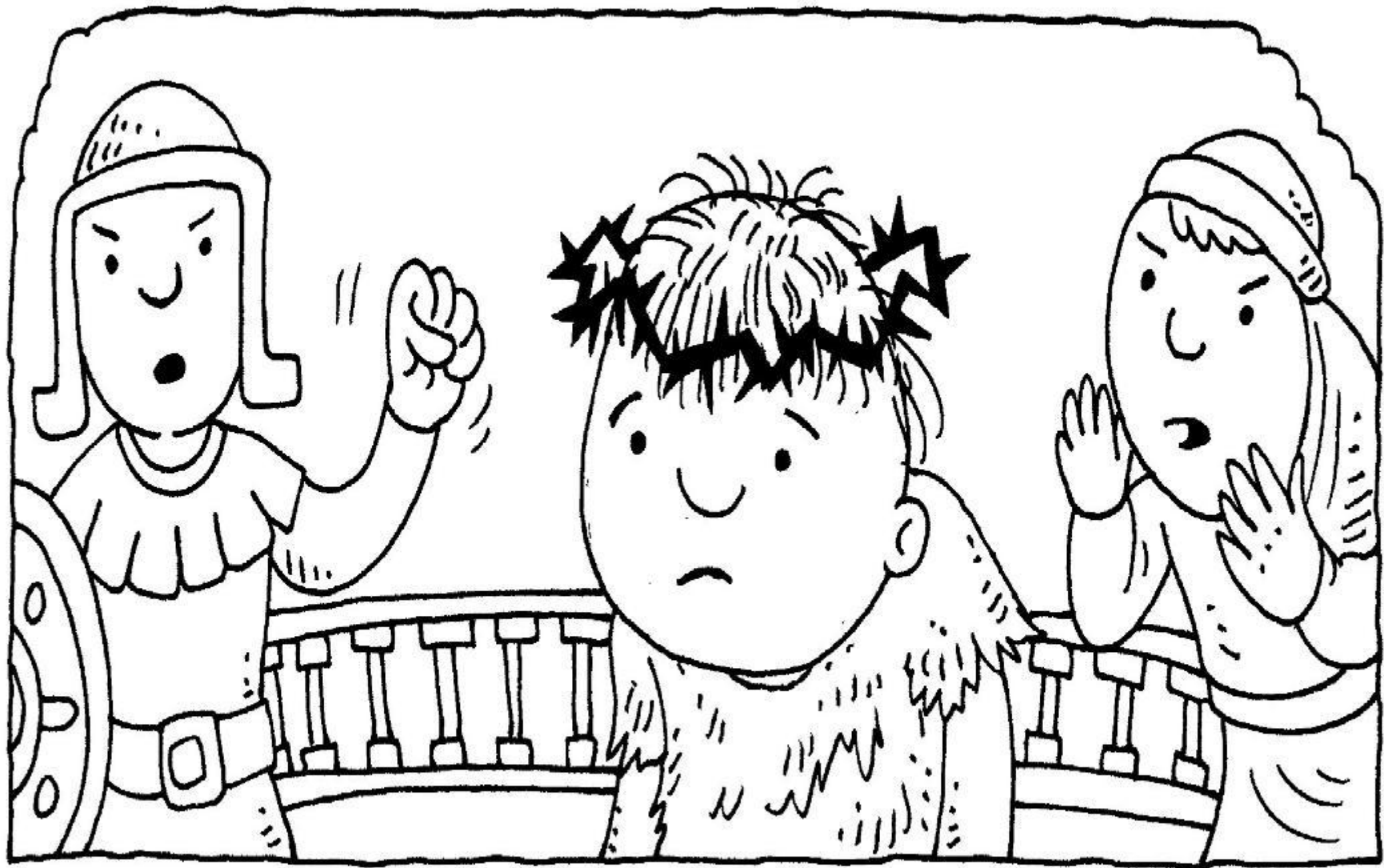
the people got mad,

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tīhaea te kākahu

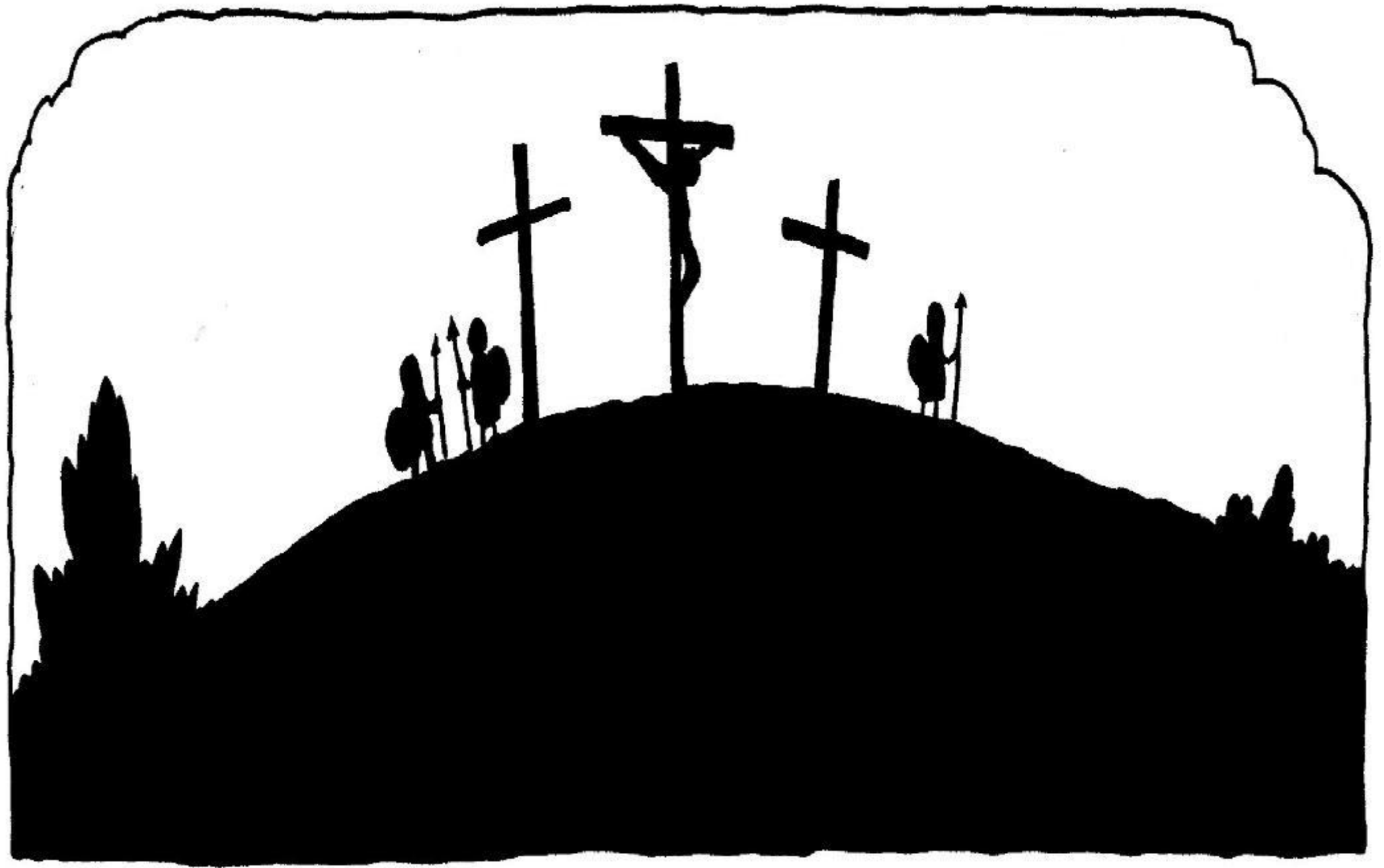
His clothing got torn

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Ka piki haere ki te puke

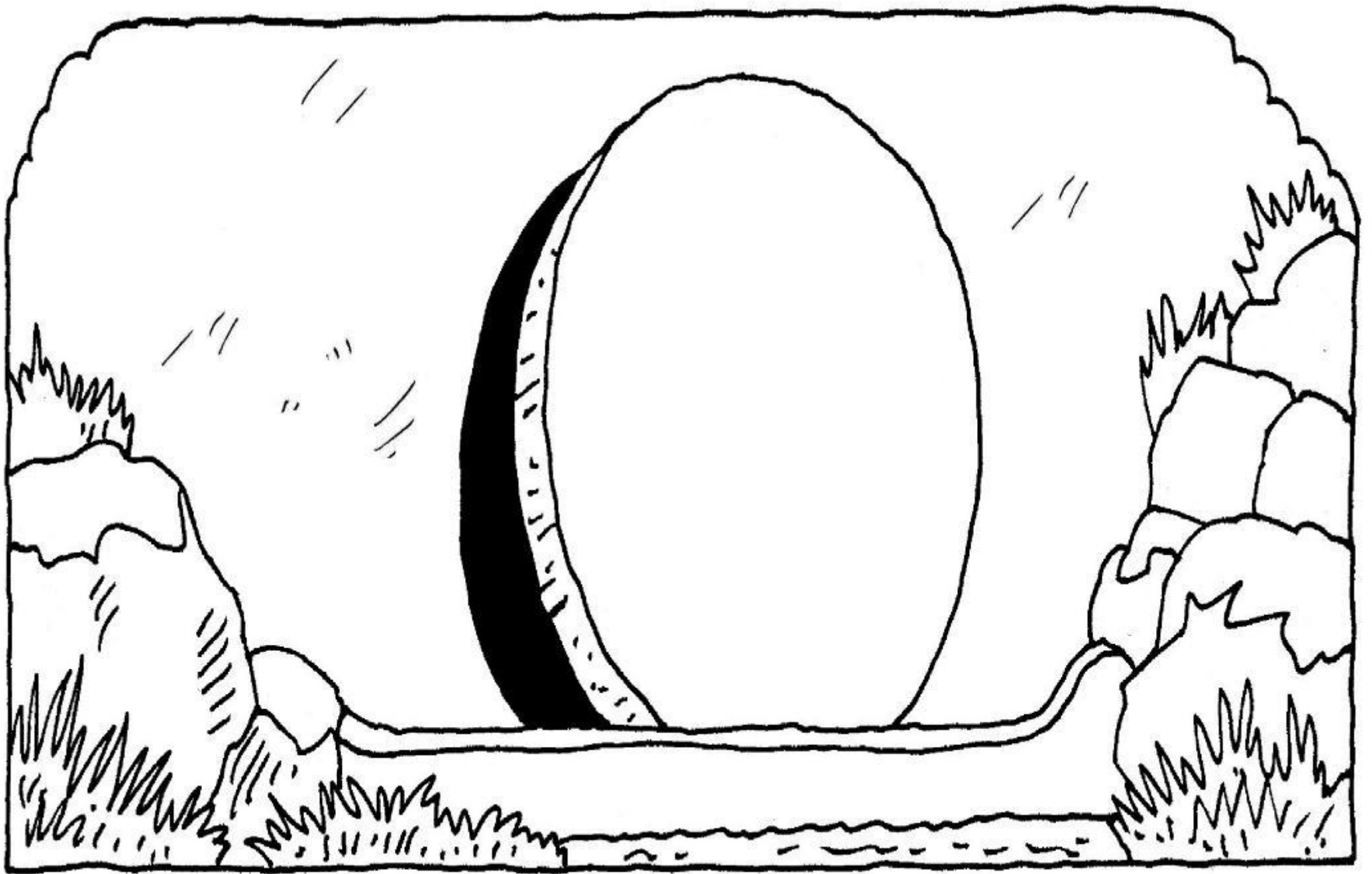
He walked up a hill

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Ka takoto ia i te urupā

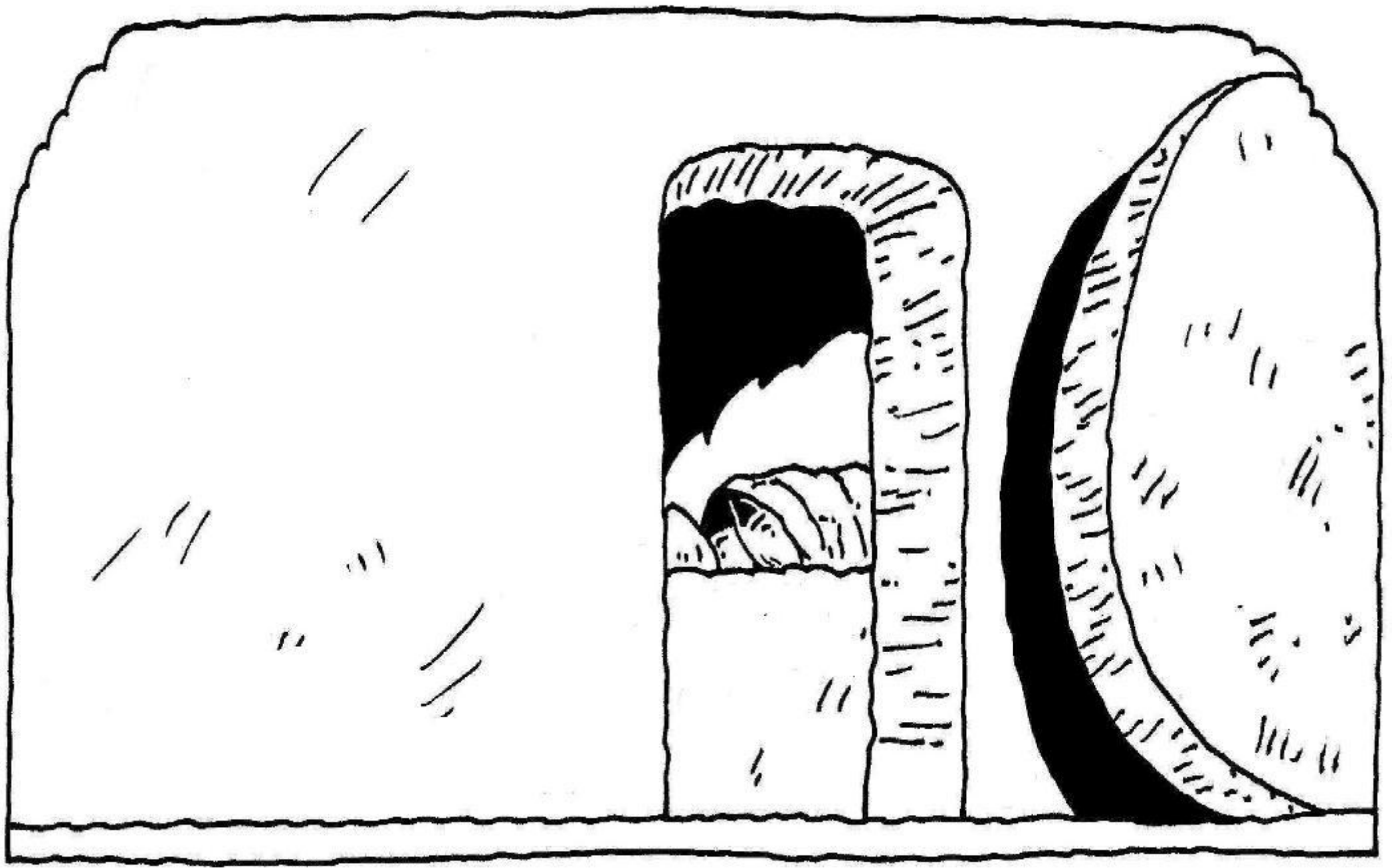
He lay dead in a tomb
